This Legacy 34 semi-custom downeast style express cruiser is ready for your cruise. Legacy 34s were designed by Mark Ellis and built by Freedom Yachts in Rhode Island through 2006, you will appreciate the Legacy hull design for comfortable cruising on seas and short chop. Cruise economically at 16-17 knots at 2700 RPM burning 1.1 NMPG.

Captain and admiral sit in luxurious Stidd seats with full 360° view and all electronics within easy reach. Move safely and easily along wide side decks with high stainless steel rails and lifelines.

Enjoy entertaining aboard with full galley to serve appetizers and nutritious meals for 6-8 guests and family, as they relax comfortably around L-shaped pilothouse settee, aft cockpit bench and salon L-shaped settee.

Beautifully crafted interior with ash wood trim and teak and holly sole makes this Legacy where you want to be. Extend your cruising season as long as you want with pilothouse and interior airconditioning and heater for comfort in summer heat and winter chill, with generator while cruising or anchored, and shorepower while at dock.

Appreciate owner's attention to maintenance and upgrades, including 2015 Imron hull and deck, and bottom paint. See full specifications for more complete list.

## WALK-THROUGH TOUR

Before stepping aboard, admire beautiful newly Imroned blue hull and white deck.

Step aboard at swim platform and enter aft cockpit through transom door. Note long aft facing cushioned bench with storage and propane locker, deck hatches for easy access to batteries, steering and water tanks.

Move up 3 steps on either side of pilothouse to walk wide decks inside high heavy duty stainless steel rails with lifelines and proceed to bow deck. Observe anchoring equipment with Ideal electric anchor windlass foot controls, dual anchor lockers with

stainless steel anchor and chain, second anchor with rope rode, washdown system. Note ample cleats and hawsepipes for securing dock lines.

Return to aft cockpit and up 3 steps to pilothouse. Notice ample ventilation through 2 overhead hatches, electric opening windshield and side opening panels. Observe the comfortable guest L-shaped cushioned settee to port with removable table, and high end Stidd captain and mate chairs. Sit in captain's chair to note electronics layout all within captain's reach, and full 360° view.

Open large center sliding door and proceed down 3 steps to salon. Note spacious head to port across from salon settee that converts to berth. Observe lovely ash wood trim to accent cabinetry and doors. Note well organized and labeled electrical panels above settee. Proceed forward to galley on port side. Observe large L-shaped countertop, deep SS sink with high faucet, 2 burner propane stove and oven, microwave oven and ample cabinet and drawer storage.

Move forward to master suite. Notice queen-size v-berth with center removable cushion. Appreciate ample storage in cabinets above port and starboard sides of v-berth and cabinets aft of v-berth. Note overhead opening hatch for added ventilation.

## **ACCOMMODATIONS**

Enjoy this very comfortable downeast express cruiser design with plenty of social space in pilothouse and salon, and private master suite. You and your guests will be comfortable in most weather with airconditioned and heated pilothouse and interior.

In pilothouse, Captain and first mate enjoy top of the line Stidd chairs, while guests gather around cushioned L-shaped settee and removable table and on aft cockpit bench.

Interior shows high craftsmanship with generous amount of ash wood trim, lots of light and cross ventilation through opening ports, lovely cabinetry, and very comfortable leather cushions on settee. Salon headroom is 6' 2", head is 6' 1", master suite is 6', and v-berth is 6' 5" long.

Spacious head with large vanity, deep stainless steel sink, Grohe temperature controlled wand shower, vacuflush toilet, opening port
