This 1999 model, currently selling new for over \$850,000, is a fantastic value at a great price for an outstanding boat. The 1999 model year still offered a true teak and holly interior with a high quality fit and finish found only on the best motor yachts. Her single engine Cummins 450 HP engine provides plenty of power at an incredibly economical fuel burn rate. At 8 knots, 1200 RPM, she's burning under 2.5 GPH, providing a range of over 1,500 NM. Her fine entry bow provides a smooth ride through choppy seas and her flat chines aft, full length keel and fully protected prop provide reliability, safety and stability. This model year in this condition is a rare find in this iconic brand.
