Moving aft into the main salon is a U-shaped settee to port with a dinette table and bench seat. The galley is across flush to starboard. Aft to port is the master head which also has access from the master stateroom. Aft to starboard is the navigation station with a companionway that leads to the aft master stateroom. The master stateroom features an athwartship double berth, hanging lockers and private access to the head. The interior is finished in custom cheery woodwork throughout.
