Overview

Bower is a fiberglass constructed sport cruiser built by *Marquis* Yachts in Pulaski, Wisconsin, United States in the year 2008. Her hull is painted metallic black with a white boot stripe. The decal name on the transom reads "Bower, Panama". There is a Plexi glass door in the port side of the transom. The house is white gel coat with metallic black painted trim. The decks are molded nonskid fiberglass. She is equipped with a built in fiberglass swim platform and a stainless steel swim ladder. There is one helm station located in the forward end of the salon, starboard side. Bower is powered by twin Volvo D6 IPS 600 marine diesels.

DETAILED INFORMATION

Manufacturer Provided Description

The 40 SC is the combined result of the Italian Naval Architectural firm of Nuvolari-Lenard and American yacht manufacturer Marquis Yachts. This yacht has brought to life a combined vision of an open boat that not only looks amazing and is built to perfection but also provides its operator and passengers with thrilling performance. Built around Volvo's innovative IPS propulsion system the Marquis 40 SC will deliver an exhilarating ride at speeds expected to exceed 40 mph. The addition of the IPS Joystick allows the operator to confidently maneuver the yacht in tight quarters and while docking. The open-air salon and adjoining cockpit is designed for maximum access to the yacht's ocean side environment. The salon entrance doors open to create one large environment combining the salon with the yacht's cockpit. The innovative transom lounge easily glides aft with a push of a button to create more than 60 square feet of cockpit space. The yacht's salon features quality treatments such as exotic African Zebrano hardwood cabinetry with high gloss quality lacquered trim, wooden cabin sole and designer selected fixtures and appointments. The interior of the Marquis 40 SC compares in materials, style, fixtures and quality to the interiors of mega and super yachts that are cruising the world.

General Description

BOWER is a cabin sport cruiser with a salon amidships, engine room under the cockpit and sleeping accommodations forward, below. She is a fully furnished and air conditioned yacht, decorated with a tan headliner, tan carpeting, tan curtains, brown leather trim and tan and brown leather upholstery. The cabinetry, doors and drawers have a zebrano wood finish.

- Glass door located port side at the forward end of the cockpit.
- Fixed front, side and aft windows and a powered sun roof overhead.

- *Sole* 28" TV on an actuated platform that rises up from the counter top

Deck

- White non-skid fiberglass foredecks, protected by a stainless steel handrail that starts in the bow and ends aft of amidships.
- Stainless steel anchor pulpit all the way forward.
- Seen stowed in this pulpit is a 25lb. galvanized Delta anchor shackled to approximately 50' of 5/16" galvanized chain tended by a *Maxwell* windlass.
- Two 10" stainless steel bow cleats.
- A *Colight* remote search light is mounted to the tip of the bow railing.
- Two 10" stainless steel breast cleats.
- A *Bomar* flush deck hatch giving ventilation the accommodations below, located in the forward center of the foredeck.
- The fore deck is designed to accommodate a sun pad with two drink holders on each side.
- Fixed plexi glass windows on each side of the sun pad.
- White fiber glass non-skid side decks with a water fill to port and two 10" stainless steel beam cleats.
- Stainless steel handrail is bolted to the house sides for safer passage along the side decks.

Cockpit

- White non-skid fiberglass cockpit decks are protected on the sides by white fiberglass bulwarks and overhead by a canvas awning.
- Plexi glass door in the port side of the transom.
- Transom bulkhead is a couch style bench seat.
- Cockpit table just forward of this couch.
- The transom moves aft by way of a hydraulic ram giving more space around the cockpit table.
- Ice maker located in the forward corner, port side.
- A refrigerator in the forward corner, starboard side.
- Fuel fills in the aft corners of the side covering boards.
- Fiberglass swim platform built into the hull.
- Aft corners of the swim platform, two 10" stainless steel stern cleats.
- Swim platform provides as well a cable master by *Glendinning* for the 125 /250 volt 50 amp shore power, TV/telephone, emergency engine shut.
- Fresh water wash down spritzer at the port side of the transom door.

- Both main engine exhaust systems consist of stainless steel exhaust elbows, Pod drive exits, joined by exhaust hose, all double clamped
- *Kohler* 13kw marine generator set, model: 13E0ZD, serial no: 2195956
- The generator is protected by a *Parker/Racor* model R-20TUL fuel filter/water separator
- Generator exhaust system consists of 3" exhaust hose from generator to a *Centek* fiber glass wet muffler, followed by 3" exhaust hose, all double clamped exiting out the transom
