DETAILED INFORMATION

Overview

Aboard the 325, you benefit from all Dufour Yachts' know-how: ergonomics, quality materials, speed, and seaworthiness. No surprise then to see this big, two cabin "little cruiser" almost handle itself as it carries the whole family off on long adventures.

Starting forward you have your typical vee-berth in a private cabin. This cabin features shelves along the hull sides, a hanging locker, reading lights and overhead ventilation provided by a large hatch.

The salon is just aft of the forward cabin. In the salon you find two straight settees that also function as single berths, one on the port side the other to starboard. There is a large center-line table, so the entire hungry crew can find a place to eat.

Starboard aft of the settee you have a large forward facing nav station. Opposite the Nav station on the port side is a very nice L-shaped galley.

Aft of the galley is the second private cabin with large double berth, shelf with fiddles over the berth and large hanging locker. Aft of the Nav station you find a large head with marine toilet, mirror, vanity with face basin and storage access.

- All joinery work is in prime Moabi mahogany, with fiddles, moldings and framings in solid wood.
- All Cabin doors have a blocking system which keeps doors open where required.
- Soles are in Moabi laminated floor boards.
- Saloon cushions and cabin mattresses have removable covers.
- The upper cabin linings are in Moabi wood, the bottom in cream vinyl.

Galley

- L-shaped galley with a large worktop in synthetic stone.
- Stainless steel sink.
- Chrome plated brass mixer tap for pressurised water.
- Propane two burner stove with oven on gimbals.
- 12V refrigerator unit with minimum capacity 120 litres, stowage box, and separation.
- Crumb tray under sole.

Electronics & Electrical

Electronics were very well thought out and professionally installed. At the helm there

was a custom added binnacle to accommodate a nice large electronics box.

Wired for both A/C and D/C current to separate breaker panels with individual breakers.

- Switchboard with circuit breakers, voltmeter, 12V outlet.
- 1 x 60 Ah engine battery.
- 1 x 60 Ah house battery.
- Battery switch for each circuit.

110 V AC System

- 30 amp shore power connection

Rigging and Sails

- Anodized aluminum mast with double swept backed spreaders, rigged 9/10, deck stepped.
- Anodized aluminum boom equipped with a two single line reefing system. Original now a spare
- *Leisure Furl Boom* (in boom furling)
- Genoa furler.
- Asymmetrical Spinnaker gear with removable pole
- Continuous standing rigging in single strand 1x19 stainless steel wire and chrome plated bronze turnbuckles including: Fore-stay, double back-stay, cap shrouds, inter and lower shrouds
- Pre-stretched running rigging including: Main and Genoa halyards, boom topping lift, Main and Genoa sheets, two reefing lines, out-haul line, furling line, boom-vang tackle.
- Elvstrom Mainsail equipped with two broad reef bands, with battens and bag.
- Elvstrom Furling Genoa with anti- UV protection.
- Jasper and Bailey 95% Self-Tacking jib

- Single stainless steel chain plate for cap shrouds/aft lower shrouds.
- Two chain plates for back-stay.
- Two deck fillers, one for water and one for fuel.
- Main sheet tackle on the roof.
- Boom-vang with 4:1 purchase.
- Genoa sheet tracks with piston lead blocks.
- Genoa sheet turning blocks on coaming.
- One x four sheave deck organizer for halyard returns, mainsail sheet and reefing lines.
- Stainless steel swan neck electric/electronic cable gland.
- Four clutches on roof.
- One x 32.2 ST halyard winch on roof.
- Two x 32.2 ST Genoa winches on coamings close to the helmsman.

Cockpit

- Teak seats and cockpit sole.
- Large side locker with lid fitted with padlock hasps.
- Rudder stock head under helmsman's sole for installing the emergency tiller.
- Engine lever and control panel easily available to the helmsman.
- Transom opens in center by removing helmsman's seat giving access to the swimming/boarding platform.
- Propane Gas cylinder locker in aft port seat.
- Life raft stowage in starboard cockpit locker.
- Cockpit shower in aft locker.
- Folding Swim ladder.






Deck Layout











Nav Station




Interior Layout




