VESSEL WALK THROUGH

Large cockpit with walk through open transom – all sail handling lines are led to the cockpit.

Upon entering below, an L-shaped Galley is to Port with aft cabin behind the Galley

To Starbd is a stand up head and shower

Moving forward there is a Nav station forward of the head along the starbd side

There are matching Settees along both the Port and Starbd sides of the Salon and a table in the middle with leaves that fold out to either side.

The master cabin is forward and has a V berth and storage lockers

There are storage shelves along each side of the Salon above the settees.

Interior is well lit with windows Port and Starbd, and well ventilated with 2 large opening hatches and several opening ports

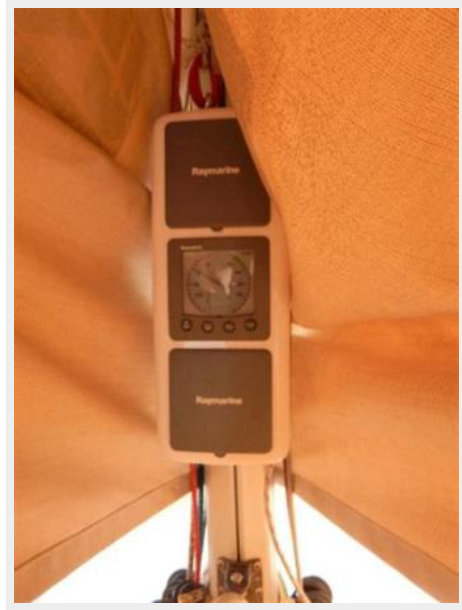
