DETAILED INFORMATION

Welcome Aboard

CELEBRATE welcomes all aboard from side gates P&S or alternatively from her large swim platform through a transom door from the integral swim platform with built-in boarding ladder. Staples on the swim platform provide safe and convenient boarding from a dink or kayaks. Folding cleats help to secure same.

There is a large lazarette beneath the aft deck. From the aft deck a Diamond Sea-Glaze Dutch door opens directly into the saloon.

In the cockpit, which is fully protected by the bridge deck overhead, there is plenty of room to relax on chairs and to set up for entertaining. The cockpit and side decks are teak.

Six fender holders allow for rigging without running lines over to of the teak caprail. The caprail is finished with Awlclear and is dazzling. A fresh water hot/cold shower is within the cockpit as is a salt and fresh water washdown.

Salon

From the aft deck a Diamond Sea-Glaze Dutch door opens directly into the saloon. There is an L-shaped dinette to port with hi/lo hidden leaf table. To starboard is a cabinet and arrangements for two teak chairs separated by a tasteful small cabinet.

LED overhead lights are ample throughout the boat. Most are controlled by dimmers.

Teak and holly soles are standard throughout the entire vessel. In the salon lay-down carpet protects the sole. In addition, these features welcome the owner's party:

- L-shaped settee to port which pulls out for an additional berth
- Two teak arm chairs to starboard
- Hi-Lo hidden leaf dining table
- TV cabinet built into galley bar for flat screen TV
- Direct TV receiver
- Stereo switchable to speakers in salon, cockpit, PH, MSR, FB
- Two Entertainment cabinets
- Hunter-Douglas custom blinds
- Diamond Sea-Glaze Dutch door entrance from aft deck
- (4) Ocean Frigast reading lights
- (4) Sliding windows with screens

Galley

The galley is to starboard at the forward end of the salon. Equipment includes:

Pilothouse

Four steps lead up to the raised pilothouse where the helm station with a full complement of electronics, a watch berth and a settee and table. Diamond Sea-Glaze Dutch doors lead out to the side decks port and starboard. To port, stairs lead up to the flybridge. The pilothouse is the center of command, is well laid out for comfort as well as efficiency.

On the port side of the galley are stairs leading down to the staterooms. The master stateroom is forward with queen bed and ensuite head. A guest stateroom is aft to port with over/under berths and a day head to starboard with stall shower. Engine room access is amidships.

Flybridge

The flybridge, accessed via a companionway directly from the pilothouse for safety and convenience, has two helm seats forward at the console with an L-shaped seating area aft to starboard. To port are the bar, sink and barbeque. There is a large deck area aft with dinghy and davit.

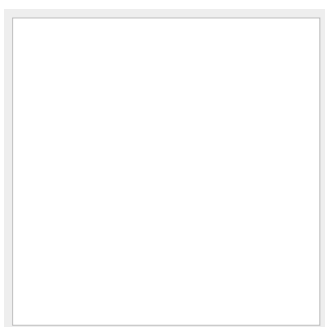

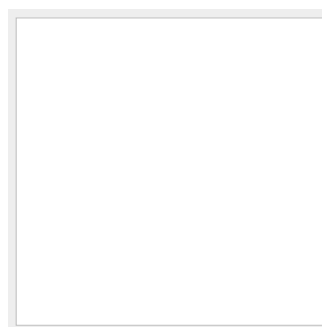

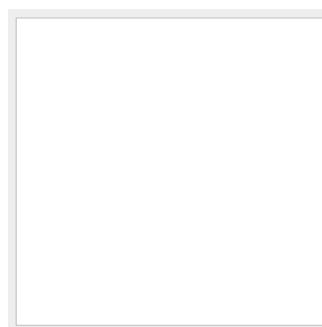

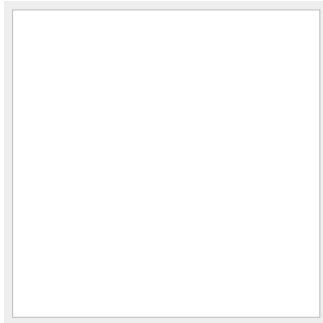

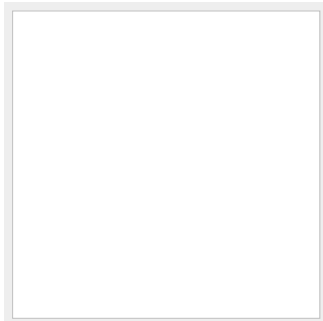
