DETAILED INFORMATION

Welcome Aboard

Phalarope is a fully found coastal cruiser ready to safely and very comfortably cruise a couple, family, or guests in US coastal waters, inland rivers, the Bahamas, Caribbean Islands, Canadian Maritimes, Great Loop, Champlain Loop, etc. **Phalarope** is the first Selene in the world to be gyro-stabilized by a Sea Keeper, which eliminates well over 80% of roll under way or at rest. We are happy to share CAD drawings of all her systems as well as links to a virtual tour so you can seen more for yourself

Cockpit and Lazarette

Phalarope welcomes all aboard from starboard side gate or alternatively from her large swim platform through a transom door. There is a large lazarette beneath the aft deck. It takes advantage of the Selene cruiser stern which extends the hull under the molded-in swim platform, not only to improve storage but also to improve performance, handling, and efficiency. In the cockpit, which is fully protected by the bridge deck overhead, there is plenty of room to relax on chairs and to set up for entertaining. The Euro design enables a cockpit comparable in size to the Selene 55. A gracious curved staircase provides safe, convenient access to the bridge and boat deck topside.

Salon

From the aft deck a Diamond Sea-Glaze Dutch door opens directly into the salon. There is an Lshaped dinette to starboard with a hidden leaf table capable of entertaining six for meals. To port is a built-in cabinet and two upholstered barrel chairs separated by a tasteful small cabinet. Ottomans with storage fit neatly beneath each chair. LED overhead lights are ample throughout the boat. Teak and holly soles are standard throughout the entire vessel. In addition, these features welcome the owner's party: • L-shaped settee w/ cushion set • Inlaid dining table with fold out hidden leaf • Access hatch to engine room • Cantalupi dome lights • Cabin reading lights (3) • Overhead Exposed Teak Battens and Epiphanes high gloss varnish • Teak overhead grab rail with Epiphanes high gloss varnish • Custom wood bamboo blinds • (2) slide opening windows with screens. They can be locked. • (2) Selene barrel chairs port side with storage foot rest • (2) independent Cruisair reverse cycle HVAC units

Galley

The galley is forward to port. Lower Helm

The lower helm is the command center of the vessel. Bridge and Upper Helm

The flybridge, accessed from the cockpit via a circular stairway for safety and

convenience, has two Selene ladder back helm seats forward at the helm with a U-shaped seating area aft to port with storage beneath. To starboard is cabinetry with fresh water sink, storage below, and prepared to serve as a barbeque. Exterior Hardware

Often the fit and finish of the interior of a yacht is noted, but the fit and finish of the exterior is very important, even though the details are subtle and regularly unnoticed. Things like cleats recessed into the bulwarks, the curved cap rail to prevent ponding, stainless window frames, etc. Here are some that help distinguish Phalarope: • Manship S/S #316 opening port lights • Manship S/S #316 hatch for forward stateroom • Starboard Dutch type door with Aluminum Sea Dawg Handles top & bottom • S/S #316 hand rail for fore deck, aft deck and flybridge decks • S/S #316 telescope ladder off of swim platform • Teak Burgee and flag staffs • S/S #316 bow and stern flag pole socket • S/S window frames • Teak cap rail for side and aft deck • Freeing ports in cockpit and scuppers at fore, side, and aft decks • Molded inlay pattern non-skid to fore, side, aft deck and boat deck. Transom door with step plate • Scandvik fresh hot and cold water shower in cockpit

FRP Structure

Invisible after construction is complete, the details of the build are critical for the long term durability and investment value. • Hull layup includes up to 12 laminates, the first four of which are infused with vinylester resin for osmotic blister protection • Bi-axis uni-direction stitched roving mat • Glass Mat • Corecell sandwich structure for hull topsides above waterline • Corecell sandwich structure for decks and superstructure • Longitudinal stringers and transverse frames system • Watertight structural bulkheads chain locker, fwd E/R, aft E/R, and lazarette • Hull and deck joint sealed by Methacrylate glue, thru bolted, and laminated with mat and woven roving where access allows • Recessed bow thruster tunnel • Integral FRP stern thruster casing • FRP Hatch for Lazarette • International Gelshield primer coating • Petit Vivid anti-fouling paint (4/16) • Awlgrip painted boot top line

Primary Interior Construction

Only a fine finish carpenter or experienced shipwright could begin to appreciate the quality of materials and workmanship invested in the renowned Selene interior fit and finish. DC Electrical System

There is so much run off of DC systems that we forget a lot of them, and sometimes don't appreciate them until actually used in service. For example the Exalto wipers. • 12V DC system • Maxwell RC10 windlass w/ control switches at foredeck and each helm station • 12V DC air horn • Aqua Signal LED navigation lights • 12V DC Exalto electric wipers for (3) front windshields w/ fresh water wash, variable speed • 12 DC sump pump w/ automatic grey water float switch • Rule bilge pumps w/ automatic float switches (3) • 12V DC 3" dia. electric exhaust fan above stove • Cantalupi

accommodation recessed lights • Cantalupi step lights for interior and exterior • Johnson 12V DC electric fresh water pump • (3) 4D AGM deep cycle batteries for house service • (1) 4D AGM engine start battery • (1) 4D AGM bow thruster battery • (1) Group 31 AGM generator starting battery • Vimar Light Switches for all DC interior lights

Plumbing Systems

Well designed and installed, Phalarope's systems cover all the bases: • Two stainless fresh water tanks 60 US gallons aft & 180 forward w/ shut off valves, sight gauges, for a total capacity 240 US gallons • Fresh and seawater outlets on foredeck • Fresh water hot and cold shower in cockpit • One FRP sewage holding tank w/ Y-valve 60 US gallons • Macerator pump, deck discharge outlet and remote warning full display panel in head for holding tank • Electric water gauge • Torrid 20 gallon hot water heater • Pex water piping system for domestic freshwater • Sea cocks on all through hull fittings with double hose clamps • Bronze basket type internal sea water strainer for main engine, Genset, Gyro, A/C • Rule Electric bilge pumps w/ automatic float switch (3) • Whale manual Diapharagm pump directable via mainifold to 3 sumps • Shower sump pump for head • Status panel w/ warning signal in helm station to alert to bilge pump operation

Fuel System

Fuel is what gets you there and back. Phalarope is engineered to carry, clean, and manage fuel to meet the needs of the voyage. That includes the onboard ESI Fuel Polishing system, rarely found in a yacht of this class. • Total capacity 700 US gallons, two FRP fuel tanks • Fuel tanks w/ internal baffles, sumps, balancing fuel lines • Fuel tank inspection ports and plates • Racor 75/900 Max dual fuel filter w/ water separator for engine • Racor dual filter w/ water separator for generator • ESI polishing system • Ball valves for fuel system configuring • Electric fuel gauge • Magnetic fuel sight gauge for each fuel tank • Selene Fuel Manifold management system • USCG Rubber fuel hoses with Parker fittings
