Accommodations

Three steps up from the cockpit and you enter a large roomy salon with rich wood paneling with a beautifully etched aft glass picture window. This window along with the side windows and the unique custom hatches along the front - that can open to allow the salon and galley to be washed with cool breezes, provides an abundance of natural lights .

The festive rug with the leather lounge and bar stools gives this salon a touch of panache'

The counter that separates the salon from the galley is long with a circular end that provides additional seating. The galley has what is necessary: full refrigerator, microwave, two burner removable stove stainless steel sink and plenty of counter space.

Heading forward, down the staircase, to a hallway that takes you to the three staterooms and two heads. The first state room, on the port side, is the master suite.

The master suite has a Queen size Pullman style berth located below a series of port lights. at the end of the berth is a large storage cabinet. The Master suite has an ensuite head and shower. The head has a macerator and is flushed with seawater.

Across the hall from the master suite is the second stateroom. This cabin has two single berth in a bunk bed arrangement. the cabin as a separated entrance to the head located on the port side.

Continuing down the hallway you'll arrive at the forward cabin with a two single berth V-berth arrangement. This cabin shares the head on the port side and there is a door that accesses the head from the hallway.

Hull and Deck

Hull

The hull is constructed of aluminum:

Thickness:

- Forward = 1/4'
- Midship = 5/16"
- Aft = 3/8"
- Area of props and struts = 1/2

2016 serviced - Any corrosion was replaced with 3/8" aluminum plate

2 Coats of epoxy and 2 coats of Anti-fouling paint

Solar Power System

The system was installed in 2016. It maintains the proper energy levels of the batteries.

The system handles all electrical functions: galley appliances, lighting, instrumentation and powering the three air conditioners.

2 kW Solar Panel System

- 8 - 250 watts solar panels
- 2 - Flexmax Controller systems - Charge controller

1/4 kW Solar Panel System - Hot Water Tank

30 gallon hot water tank heated by its own system.

"Caroline" is a 1984, 62' Striker. It's a long distance sports fisherman; easily driven from the fly bridge with the panorama view. The large cockpit, bright spacious salon, clean and uncluttered galley and three staterooms makes living aboard a pleasure.

A major plus to this yacht is the newly installed solar system that creates the electrical power needed to run all systems - including the air conditioners. This provides the unique advantage of not being tethered to a dock and enjoying all the creature comforts of this outstanding boat.

The aluminum hull has been serviced in 2016: two coats of epoxy and two coats of anti-fouling paint. This yacht is ready to go.
