Fabric colour exterior covers in Weathermax Silver from Weathermax collections To supply and fit Samsung 46" TV Set in crew mess area in place of standard 32" TV Set To supply protection covers to all internal furniture and carpets (Fabric colour covers in Weathermax Silver from Weathermax collections) Heavy cotton twill covers to be manufactured in a cream colour (agreed with Mark Berryman) The covers would comprise of all tables, all loose chairs, all sofas, carpets and main walkways through areas of timber flooring. To supply protection covers to all external furniture (Fabric colour exterior covers in Weathermax Silver from Weathermax collections) As an additional sun lounger has been specified on 40M012 this will need an additional cover.
