DETAILED INFORMATION

Broker's Comments

CAVALLINO is absolutely the finest and most updated example of an 87' Johnson motor yacht available in today's Market. Her zero speed stabilization system gives the vessel a comfort level that is not found on any "Sistership". The owners completed a \$600,000 plus re-fit in 2017. Her recent \$400,000 price reduction prices her at almost \$200,00 less than the 2005 model that is available.

- Complete replacement and upgrade of all audio/visual systems including brand new HD satellite television and stereo components with Crestron iPad touch control, new 4G cellular phone system, security and fire alert system, and recommissioning and upgrading of all bridge navigation technology.
- Total softgoods renewal including carpet, window treatments, bed coverings and all mattresses throughout by Liz Dalton Design of Jupiter.
- Electrical system upgraded by Wards Electric to include load balancing transformers to increase capacity of 50 and 100 amp systems with a new custom control panel.
- Upgrade of HVAC system including installation of two new air conditioning chill water compressors with new pumps and complete cleaning of ducts.
- Installation of brand new black water sewage system that included all new Dometic toilets throughout.
- Swim platform lift (2500 lb) and all other hydraulics onboard including warping capstans, windless', and all engine room hydraulics rebuilt with new hoses and valves October 2016.
- All new galley appliances including JENN AIRE refrigerator, LG oven/cooktop, range hood, dishwasher, and stove.
- All other refrigeration replaced on bridge, aft deck, crew quarters, salon bar and wine cooler installed in VIP stateroom.
- All interior & exterior lighting upgrade to LED.
- Haul-out in October 2016 with bottom paint, propellers balanced and running gear coated with prop-speed.

Walk-Through

With a huge beam of 23' 6", all spaces onboard are incredibly generous and immediately noticed upon boarding. Great importance has been placed on all entertaining spaces throughout the vessel. The huge aft deck has a centerline U-shaped banquette with a custom adjustable dining table and comfortable seating for 8, complemented by a cabinet with an Iso-Therm refrigerator and opposite a custom cabinet for storage. Forward are the automatic stainless and glass entry doors to the salon with an auto open function. The oversized salon area is 18x20 feet with a feeling

of extreme comfort. The room is paneled in teak and contains many highly customized features including a new 44" Sony4k HD television on the aft bulkhead. Forward on each side of the salon are leather sofas with matching ottomans to starboard, and a large custom coffee table to port. Natural light abounds in the room due to four over-sized rectangular windows on each side bulkhead. The salon contains abundant storage cabinetry and all new soft furnishings which complement the granite and woodwork perfectly. The dining area is on the forward salon bulkhead and open to the salon. The inlaid teak pedestal table and chairs accommodate 8 for dining. There is an inset tray ceiling with accent lighting and beveled mirrors with halogen spots over the dining area with a large custom designed display cabinet with mullioned glass doors and interior lighting behind the dining table for plate and stemware storage. The sole of the salon is teak and holly throughout with a rug in the center for accent. On the port side forward is the very efficient and recently upgraded Galley. There is a Pantograph door to the side walkway that allows easy access for grocery delivery and a pocket door aft that closes off the galley for privacy while guests are dining.

Salon

Because of the yacht's extra wide beam, the salon, even with its walk around side decks, is wider than similar sized yachts without walk-around side decks. Immediately to starboard upon entering the salon is a walk-behind bar. The bar has a two-level marble countertop with a stainless steel undermount sink. Below the bar is a new U-line icemaker/refrigerator combo with two storage cabinets. Above is a mirrored wine glass cabinet with glass front door.

There is a three-person leather sofa with storage below with two matching leather ottomans with storage within. There is a four door buffet with an inlaid burl wood design carried out throughout the yacht. Immediately to port upon entering the salon is the yacht's completely upgraded entertainment system with a 44" Sony HDTV and sound system with a Crestron high tech entertainment system with new HDTV and stereo components. The lighting system is sophisticated with dimmer function creating perfect ambiance. There are automatic "Silhouette" blinds on all windows throughout. There is a four person leather settee with storage and a hidden subwoofer below. In front of the sofa is a custom built coffee table with storage within. Next forward is a four-door buffet used to store the yacht's china. Also in the salon are full drapes across the aft door, four large port and starboard windows with electrically operated drapes, and rope lights behind the soffit. Each mullion between the windows is wrapped with burl wood and features a sconce light. Overhead is a recessed ceiling detailed with beveled mirrored panels, rope lights, and seven overhead mini spots including 20 overhead halogen mini spots, SMX digital AC controls.

Dining Salon

The dining area is forward and open to the salon. This area features a pedestal wood dining table set upon two fluted columns. A leather curved three-person settee faces aft with storage below. Above the table is an inset tray ceiling with rope lights beveled edge mirrors and seven halogen mini spots. Forward of the settee are four glass door cabinets with glass shelves lit from above with LED lights. To both port and starboard under the side windows are four cabinets each side for additional dining area storage.

Galley

The extremely functional and modernized galley has been upgraded in 2016. U-Shaped for maximum efficiency Wood & beveled edge glass sliding pocket entry door from Dining Salon Cabinets are lacquered off white in color to give the feeling of a larger space Countertops are granite Flooring is teak & holly **Full-size Jenn Air stainless steel double door refrigerator freezer with water & ice thru door - new 2016** Ceran top Bosch Inductive cook top w/(4) burners, hood with light and fan, and sea rail Whirlpool stainless steel dishwasher **Oversized AEG stainless steel built-in oven - new 2016 Faber exhaust system and hood - new 2016** Blanco stainless steel sink Grohe spray faucet Smoke/fire alarm Hi-lo lift for toaster/coffeemaker (5) Overhead halogen lights Pantograph portside deck door for ease of loading groceries SMX A/C control Sea Recovery watermaker control Large fixed portside window with drapes Lacquered overhead panels in lieu of vinyl for ease of cleaning

Starboard Side Main Deck Companionway / Day Head

Going forward from the starboard side of the Salon is the Accommodation Companionway. Immediately inboard is the Day Head with a marble sole and matching countertop. The vanity has one cabinet below and an under mount china sink above with a single lever faucet.

The toilet is a newly installed Sea-Land Dometic MasterFlush model. The overhead is mirrored and the walls are lacquered with a wood/burl wood wainscoating.

Opposite is a Pantograph door to the starboard side deck.

Pilothouse

The Pilothouse in CAVALLINO is fully functional, and the yacht's newly upgraded main helm. The helm is on centerline with an excellent 270 degree view out of seven curved signature Johnson windows. To port is a raised black leather L-shaped settee offering excellent visibility. Outboard of the settee is an upholstered day bed. Centerline aft are four steps with step lights and a sliding stainless and glass door to the Flybridge Helm

Area. Aft cabinets conceal the yacht's newly upgraded fire alarm system, newly installed Elk security system, Firenet Marine system by Hochiki systems and MTU computers. **At the helm station there is a new 2016 EXACQ Vision CCT with four cameras.** A hinged top storage cuddy offers additional storage. Two black leather electrically adjustable Bessezoni helm chairs offer a commanding view.

The helm consists of the following equipment: **A fully custom-built computer system with Nobeltec, KVH7 satellite with DirecTV receivers and Apple TV, Elk security with Firenet Marine system by Hochiki Systems, and EXACQ Vision CCTV with four cameras. The fire system is especially notable with ringer and text ability for cellular telephones - new 2016** Two Navnet VX2 10.1 inch LCD screens for plotter/radar/sounder Two MTU electronic engine monitor panels MTU electronic single lever engine controls Simrad AP25 auto pilot Simrad joystick steering control Two Maxwell windless controls VDO rudder angle indicator Danforth Constellation 5 inch magnetic compass in chrome binnacle **12 inch monitor for EXACQ Vision CCTV with four cameras - new 2016** Icom M 602 VHF Jabsco search light controls ABT integrated bow and stern thruster control ABT LCD stabilizer control panel Raymarine Tridata for depth/speed & log Port & starboard exhaust high temperature alarm system (8) Fuel filter alarms, audio & visual 14 Station fire alarm monitoring panel audio & visual Trim tab controls Engine alarm panel Start/stop key switches Six place bilge pump monitor system with high water alarms Headhunter fuel tank sentry with LED lights for four individual tanks Headhunter LED water tank meter Twenty eight breaker protected pilot house DC circuits Digital volt & amp meters at breaker panel Seafire engine shutdown override system Service point for KVH sat dome Thrane & Thrane sat phone system Also in this area are digital AC controls, (8) overhead halogen mini spots, (2) stereo speakers, (6) step lights and a backlight handrail

Master Stateroom

The Master Stateroom in CAVALLINO could easily pass for a stateroom on a 120 foot yacht. Being on the main deck the view is excellent from the nine curved heavy tinted signature glass windows.

The berth is a full king size on the aft bulkhead. Besides six drawers below there is abundant storage under the berth via gas shock hinges. The headboard is of Ultra Leather panels which extends overhead to an air conditioning delivery soffit and ceiling detail almost the size of the berth. Either side of the berth are built in nightstands with one cabinet each and wood countertops above. Above each nightstand is a beveled glass mirror with a brass swing arm lamp.

To the starboard side, are four cabinets followed by a vanity with stool and drawer followed by two additional cabinets. A halogen desk lamp is above the vanity. On the portside the cabinets are identical with the addition of a two person leather settee with

storage below. **At the foot of the berth is an oval shaped TV cabinet with a new Crestron high tech entertainment system with new 44" Sony4k HDTV and stereo components. There is also a new tv lift system installed June 2016.**

Master Stateroom windows are enclosed with blackout drapes. Also in this cabin are five JL Audio ultra high end speakers for Surround Sound, fourteen overhead halogen mini spots, a hidden safe and dual access to the huge Master Head.

Master Head

The Master Head of CAVALLINO can only be described as opulent. Four marble steps from either side of the TV cabinet lead down to a marble soled open head arrangement. Each step has rope lighting under the toe kick. Centerline is a unique tub/shower arrangement with two opening doors facing aft. Besides a Moen rain type showerhead affixed to the mirrored overhead, are five directional body sprays and a handheld Grohe shower fixture. To the portside are twin China under mount sinks below a marble countertop. There are three cabinets in the vanity below and four beveled edge mirrored medicine cabinets above. Under soffit lighting gives a very dramatic effect. Opposite to starboard there is a new Sealand Dometic toilet and matching bidet. There are walk-in his & hers hanging lockers with mirrored doors on each aft bulkhead of the bath. The bath is lit by halogen spots and has a mirrored overhead. There is a floor hatch access to a large below deck storage area.

Lower Deck Companionway

Nine teak and holly steps each with a step light lead to the Accommodation Deck below. The handrails are backlit, a great night light. Also in this area is a central vac outlet. At the foot of the steps are four cabinets to serve as a stewardess locker. Going aft is a curved marble countertop with a mirror above flanked two wood columns. To starboard is the queen berth Stateroom, to port is another queen berth Stateroom. Forward is the king sized VIP Cabin.

VIP Stateroom

The VIP Cabin has a king sized berth off the forward bulkhead with six drawers below the berth. Additional storage is available under the mattress via hinged gas shocks. The headboard is padded Ultra Leather. Above is a two level soffit including reading lights and air conditioning delivery. Raised night stands with two cabinets each flank the berth. Mirrored panels with sconce lights are above the night stands. To starboard is a cabinet with a drawer and two cabinet doors followed by a two person Ultra

Leather settee. Outboard and above are eight cabinet doors. Further above are two opening stainless steel portholes with storm blackout covers hidden behind four sliding Soji screens. Next aft is a large cedar lined hanging locker. **There is a new Crestron high tech entertainment system with new HDTV and stereo components.** Below is a three shelf cabinet and a drawer. On the portside of the VIP there are two drawers and four cabinets below, eight cabinets above and two matching portholes with blackout storm covers behind sliding Soji screens. Aft is a hinged top vanity with a swing out stool and swing out work light above. Next aft is the entrance to the VIP head. Also in the VIP stateroom are ten overhead halogen mini spots, five overhead stereo speakers, SMX AC controls and a carpeted sole. Newly installed U-Line wine cooler in 2016.

VIP Head

The VIP Head has a bow front vanity with two storage cabinets below and a marble countertop with and under mount China sink above. There are three mirrored panels, above the inboard one opening for a medicine cabinet. The toilet is a Sealand Dometic model. The sole is marble and the overhead is mirrored. The stall shower has a hinged tempered glass door, a seat, a wall mounted or handheld Grohe shower fixture, two storage cabinets, an opening stainless steel porthole with a blackout cover, with a weather cover and drapes and a mirrored overhead, exhaust fan and light.

Starboard Guest Stateroom

The Starboard Guest Stateroom has an athwartship berth off the outboard bulkhead with three drawers below. Either side is a built in nightstand with one cabinet door forward and two aft. Above the berth are four storage cabinets and two opening stainless steel portholes with blackout weather covers behind sliding Soji screens. The inboard bulkhead has two cedar lined hanging lockers flanking a vanity with a drawer and a stool. **There is a new Crestron high tech entertainment system with new HDTV and stereo components.** Forward is the access to the en suite Head. Overhead are eight halogen mini spots, two stereo speakers and a carpeted sole.

Starboard Guest Head

The Starboard Guest Head is accessed only from the Starboard Guest Stateroom. The bow front vanity has two cabinet doors below a marble countertop and an under mount china sink. There is a beveled edged mirror over the sink. The toilet is a Sealand Dometic model. Above the toilet are two storage cabinets with three halogen mini spots, a mirrored overhead and an opening stainless steel porthole with blackout storm cover and drapes. The stall shower has a hinged tempered glass door, a handheld or

wall mounted Grohe shower fixture, a seat and two mirrored storage cabinets outboard. Also in the shower is a mirrored overhead, two lights and an exhaust fan.

Port Guest Stateroom

The Port Guest Stateroom has a double berth aft and outboard with padded Ultra Leather headboard with two swing out lamps above. There are two storage drawers below the berth. Inboard is a two drawer nightstand with a mirrored panel above. Outboard of the berth are six cabinet doors and two opening stainless steel blackout portholes with weather covers behind Soji screens. **There is a new Crestron high tech entertainment system with new HDTV and stereo components.** Forward is a cedar lined auto lit hanging locker. Furthest forward is the entrance to the Cabin's en-suite Head.

Port Guest Head

The Port Guest Head is accessed from the Port Guest Stateroom. The bow front vanity has two cabinet doors below a marble countertop and an under mount china sink. There is a beveled edged mirror over the sink. The toilet is a Sealand Dometic model. Above the toilet are two storage cabinets with three halogen mini spots, a mirrored overhead and an opening stainless steel porthole with blackout storm cover and drapes. The stall shower has a hinged tempered glass door, a handheld or wall mounted Grohe shower fixture, a seat and two mirrored storage cabinets outboard.

Crew Quarters

Access to the Crew Cabin is via a portside deck Pantograph door and down nine teak and holly steps. At the base of the stairs one can go aft to the Captain's Cabin or forward to the Crew Mess with Crew Area. Furthest to starboard is a second Crew Cabin.

Captain's Quarters

Private Captain's Cabin is to port and has a tapered double berth and six storage drawers below. Inboard is a cedar lined auto lit hanging locker. Outboard are seven storage cabinets and a stainless steel opening porthole with blackout weather cover and drapes. SMX AC controls Icom M 502 VHF Furuno RD-30 remote data display At the foot of the berth is a Sharp 15 inch LCD TV

A cabinet within the Captain's Cabin offers access to a huge storage area under the garage as well as an emergency escape.

En-suite to the Captain's Cabin is an enclosed head with a corner vanity and one cabinet below with granite countertop and china under mount sink.
