DETAILED INFORMATION

Walk around

You can board the vessel from either the side or through the removeable stern transom gate. There is a large open area behind the center console with coaming bolsters extending about 6 feet along each side. The center console has a bench seat with back rest and the removeable live well is located below. There is storage in the bench seat and in the electronics box above the helm. The beam of the boat is carried almost to the bow and presents a wide open area for passengers and fishing. An inset fishing tackle locker is located on the front of the console and a 72 quart cooler with a cushioned seat is below. There is storage for 2 rods under each gunnel and there are a total of 12 rod holders. There is an anchor locker with anchor and rode between the hulls in the bow.

Catamaran advantages

Catamaran hull has less wetted surface leading to less drag and more fuel efficiency

- Remarkably soft ride in rough sea due to narrow hulls and no flat underside surfaces thus nearly eliminating hull slap.
- 8 foot 6 inch beam is carried almost all the way forward creating more room than a similar size monohull
- Twin engines providing redundancy, excellent maneuverability, and a balanced ride
- Engines mounted in line with each hull creating a wide distance between the engines. This allows outstanding 'twin screw' maneuvering at low speed.
- Shallow draft of 11 inches for inshore fishing and exploration
- Room for large, stable, bow fishing platform

- 12 rod holders- 4 on the t-top, 2 on the helm bench, 4 built in on the port and starboard stern quarter, and 2 mounted to the bow rail.
- Lexan wrap around windshield
- 72 quart igloo cooler with cushion

- Aluminum t-top frame with green canvas top
- Removable live well with sea water pump and thru hull drain
- Bow anchor locker with anchor and rode.
- Coaming bolsters extending approximately 6 feet up the port and starboard side and turning in approximately 1 foot along the transom

- Engines mounted aft of the transom providing a built in swim platform
- 8 foot 6 inch beam carried almost the full length of the boat
- 4 t-top lights, 2 facing forward and 2 facing aft
- T-top mounted vhf antenna
- Ritchie compass
- Electronics and storage box mounted above the console
- Storage under the bench seat
- Storage under the console
- Stainless steel bow rail with attached rod holders
- Aluminum foot rest under the helm bench
- Stern pop up cleats
- Hull mounted running lights
- Rub rail

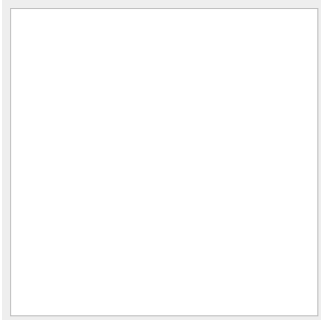

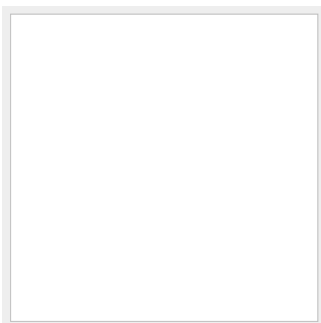

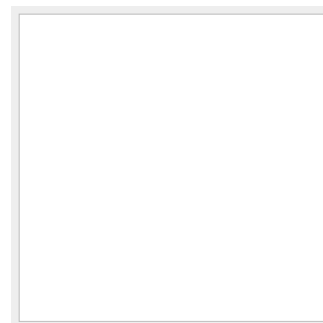

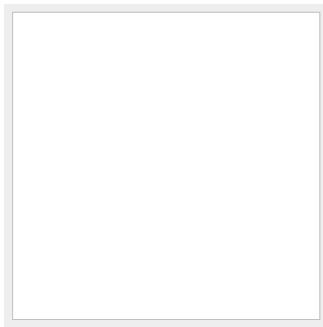

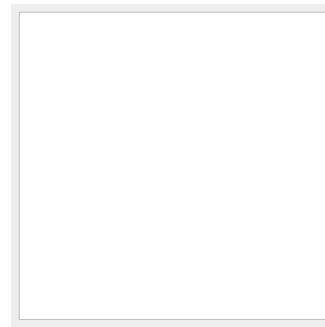

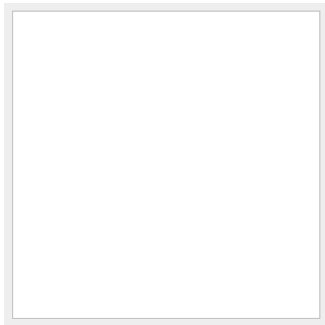

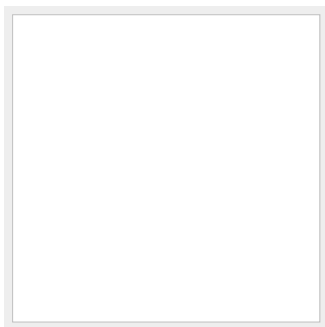

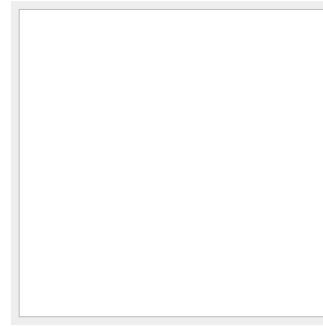

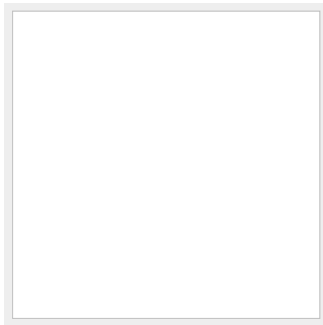

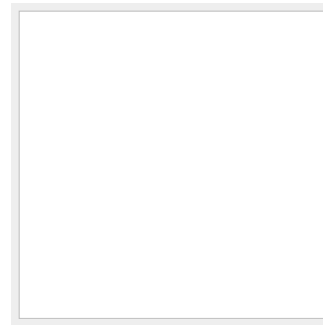

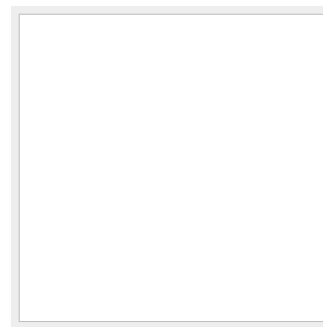
