Enjoy her spaciousness - above and below decks. With 33' 11" LOA and 11' 4" beam, Seat 8 on deck under the bimini in the large wrap-around cockpit seating on custom made cushions and removable sternrail seats. Below deck, enjoy extra height in large salon - 6' 3" headroom!! Salon settees seat 8 for games, conversation and meals around large table. Enjoy any chef's favorite U-shaped fully-equipped galley. Relax and sleep in comfortable master and forward suites. This is the roomiest 33' sloop you'll find. Lovely woodwork throughout salon and cabins gives a luxurious interior.

Walk Through Tour

Step aboard at side gate onto nonskid deck and down to cockpit. Notice the lovely decorative teak on U-shaped cockpit seating with custom cushions around the folding table. Admire the well-organized helm with all instruments mounted on pedestal within easy reach and sight. Easily lower helm seat and step through open transom to sugar scoop swim platform and folding swim ladder. Step past sheet controls and winches at cockpit to walk safely forward on nonskid decks within double lifelines. At bow pulpit, take note of electric anchor windlass and roller furling genoa.

Return to cockpit past in-mast furling main sail to go down 4 moulded steps to salon. Enjoy 6' 3" headroom! Large U-shaped galley is immediately to port with double deep sinks, 2 burner propane stove and oven, microwave and top loading refrigerator/freezer. Take a moment to appreciate the amount of countertop and storage space in this galley.

Step starboard of companionway to find head with marine toilet, moulded vanity and sink and wand shower with storage and mirror. Move aft and enter door to master suite with huge queen berth and cabinet storage. Now proceed forward through salon with settees to port and starboard. Mastpost mounted large wood table swings to serve guests on both settees and

lowers to create double berth for guests. Note storage shelves above settees and under settee storage. Proceed forward past salon to door entering guest suite with double v-berth, hanging locker and cabinet storage.

Accommodations

This Beneteau 331 is the most spacious sailboat you'll find. After a great day sailing, swimming, sunbathing and dining in the roomy cockpit, enjoy relaxing in the spacious salon for card games and conversation around the settees and table, or quiet reading. Take in plenty of fresh air through opening ports and overhead hatches. Enjoy airconditioning and heat as necessary when at dockside shorepower.

Sleep guests and family comfortably aboard in the forward double v-berth cabin and on the salon settees. Table drops to convert starboard settee to double berth; port settee converts to single berth. Owners retire to their spacious master suite with queen berth aft. Reading lights strategically located in master and guest cabins. Amidship head serves owners and guests, with marine toilet, moulded vanity sink and cabinet, and wand shower.
