- Full length starboard settee, with expanded 29" depth and custom Kravet Soleil #25763-1114 Terry Chenille fabric cushions. Starboard settee pulls out for sleeping.
- Starboard side overhead pad eyes for lee cloths.
- Two folding single benches with Kravet Soleil #25794-5 Tropical Navy seat covers.
- Continuous raised handrails port and starboard for safety.
- Toshiba 55" Flat screen TV, bulkhead mounted.
- Tall, pole storage locker in front of mast.
- Full access to storage both behind, and below settee seat cushions
- Modified return divider at Nav station.

- European style headliner with wide edge battens.
- Additional a/c outlets added at factory.

Nav Station

- Custom Hylas "L shape" with opening computer compartment aft, and bi-fold outboard facing chart table top.
- Hinged instrument panel for drop down access to electronics.
- Deep drawers with lower filing cabinet.
- Custom swing out chair design with rounded seat back and special HP 1256 Papyrus fabric.
- Electrical panel at aft end of chart desk has cut away underneath to allow for chart space.
- Gen-set controls are thoughtfully mounted on the forward edge within easy reach and clear of the hinged instrument panel.
- Ample extra 110AC outlets in cabinet and computer compartment; fan over Nav station desk.
- Center Island outboard section on port side of sink has stainless steel work area hidden by custom teak cover.

- Vitrifrigo DW210 Double Drawer SS Refrigeration below the counter forward.

- Custom installed La Marzocco 1647 Espresso Machine, side placed roll-up cabinet with sliding shelf for Mazzer Luigi Espresso Grinder, and two additional a/c outlets.
- Two galley opening ports outboard, and two extra opening ports to cockpit for cross ventilation.
- Raised panel cabinets, with owner designed drawer layout.
- Double routed teak fiddles along galley island for accent.
- Single, deep stainless steel sink and imported faucet, with bright LED lighting above.
- Queen Long trademark knife storage at forward end of galley counter.
- Fresh and Salt Water Foot pumps.

Owners Stateroom and Head Details

Centerline queen berth with custom mattress and mattress fiddles; elegantly curved, six

drawer teak berth base.

- Starboard side settee with custom cabinet layout and flush mount air conditioning vent.
- Starboard hanging locker was redesigned with five drawers and fiddle at top.
- Portside hanging locker has split cabinet doors and a fiddle above the locker.
- There is a portside Vanity Cabinet and a stereo volume control aft.
- Large aft hatch has a teak trimmed Ocean Air screen and shade.
- A 32" Panasonic flat screen TV mounted on the forward bulkhead.
- Two teak handrails were added to headliner at the forward end of berth for safety.
- Six (6) lee cloth pad eyes are fastened on the headliner above the berth.
- The spacious head aft has a teak and ebony sole and mirrored cabinets.
- Custom fit sink, imported faucets and Granite RDG20 black counter.
- Quiet Flush electric head, with holding tank monitor and Sealand discharge pump.
- Large shower with imported fixtures and clear Lexan door.
- A full mirror is mounted outside of the owner's head door.
- The Splendide 2100 Vented Washer Dryer is cabinet mounted in the shower and vents to deck.

- Center line gueen berth with split cabinets underneath and mattress fiddle.
- Headboard covered with padded Kravet Soleil #27085-16 custom fabric.
- Bulkhead mounted Samsung 21" TV
- Centerline hatch has a teak trimmed Ocean Air screen and shade.
- Starboard Hanging Locker with settee; port side upper cabinet with shelf.
- Full length mirror on passage door.
- Forward head sole is teak and ebony.
- Quiet Flush electric head, with holding tank monitor and Sealand discharge pump.
- Custom fit sink and imported shower faucets on RDG 20 black granite counter.
- Beveled edge cabinet mirrors.
- Clear Lexan shower stall door

Portside Guest Cabin Features

- Upper and lower berths. Lower lifts for storage.
- Upper and lower cedar lined hanging lockers forward, with removable shelves.
