CONSTRUCTION

Solid fiberglass hull, reinforced with additional laminations in all stress areas. Deck is set in a 6' flange which is molded into the hull, fiberglass and bolted to form a permanent hull/deck joint. Nonskid pattern is molded into the deck.

- External lead keel is fastened with stainless steel bolts
- Bronze centerboard with electric motor operated from helm
- Solid teak guard rail runs full-length just below sheer to protect topsides from pilings.
- Propane tanks are new 2015 installed in lazarette locker (sealed and drained overboard)
- New toerail, taffrail and rubrail built, fresh varnish 2016

COCKPIT

A large comfortable cockpit incorporates seating all the way around with new teak and varnished coamings designed at a height and angle for optimal back support when seated.

Cockpit features include:

- Dodger White Sunbrella (2016)
- Bimimni Sunbrella (2016)
- White Cockpit closed-cell cockpit cushions with Hinckley gold pen stripe, plus extra matching backrests
- Edson pedestal wheel steering with integrated engine gear and throttle controls and binnacle mounted compass
- Stainless steel 40" wheel
- Hinckley folding varnished teak cockpit table mounted on pedestal
- New varnished teak cockpit coaming has built-in winch pockets.

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- Watertight locking, opening seats offer locker storage.
- Cockpit floodlight
- Electric motor control for centerboard with 8 position gauge mounted to port of helm
- Engine gauges behind plexiglass cover mounted in recess at forward end of cockpit with good visibility from helm.

ACCOMMODATIONS BELOW

- Sleeps 6, owners and guests in 2 staterooms.
- Seat cushions are new 2016, covered in Teal fabric
- Storage below starboard and port seats
- Bookshelf to port and starboard side
- New 2015 Mermaid 16.5k BTU AC/heat with outlets in main and forward cabins
- Forward door access to storage chain locker in forepeak
- Hanging locker to starboard
- Large Hinckley overhead hatch provides great ventilation (hinges can open either forward or aft) and natural light
- Fixed port lights in varnished mahogany cabin liner provide additional light.
- Storage for companionway hatch screens above berth

Master Stateroom:

- Large V-berth forward, sleeps 2 on 6 inch mattress.
- V-berth has seat between.
- There is drop front and drawer storage under the berths.
- Bookshelf outboard over berth port and starboard.
- Large hanging locker to starboard.
- 4-drawer Bureau with full shelf to port with additional storage access behind drawers.

MAIN CABIN

The forward stateroom has a V-berth with filler piece that creates a larger sleeping area, and drawer storage below. There is shelving above both berths, and 2 hanging lockers to starboard, and more storage to port. Aft to port is the updated head, and another hanging locker to starboard. The main salon has a center line drop leaf table, and can feed a crowd of 9 if needed. The salon also has upper and lower berths port and starboard sides. The port side galley with new counters, and a Ship Mate propane 3 burner stove with oven. She sleeps 6 in comfort. Main salon cushions are new in 2016.

- Varnished large mahogany dinette table with 2 folding leafs
- 4 white finished Swivelier reading lights at either end of the cabin
- Large Hinckley overhead hatch with removable screen provides additional natural light and ventilation
- Dorade vent forward allows fresh air even when hatches are closed
- Forward of the seating to starboard is a large bureau with shelf and a locker with louvered doors above
- Portside bulkhead mounted with Chelsea barometer

- The head is finished with a Corian countertop (2016)
- Kohl satin Stainless Steel sink with a new faucet and shower fixtures (2016)
- Hot and cold pressure water by Isotemp hot water heater (2015)
- Telephone-style shower
- Jabsco head with Y-valve to an 18-gallon holding tank or overboard discharge facility.
- Storage in lockers outboard of counter and below sink.
- Teak medicine cabinet

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- Stainless steel towel bar/grab
- Overhead dorade provides continuous ventilation
- Opening brass port with screen for additional light and ventilation

- Double stainless steel sink, single lever stainless faucet with pull out sprayer (2015)
