DETAILED INFORMATION

36' Grand Banks Vessel Walkthrough

From the covered aftdeck, you can walk out either side deck on the same level, step up the ladder to the flybridge or walk through the sliding teak & glass door entrance to the salon. Once inside the salon, you will find lounge chairs and book-end cabinetry to starboard, the lower helm and a side deck access door starboard forward, the stateroom entrance forward, galley port forward and a settee and hi/lo table to port. Engine room access is via salon sole hatches.

The headroom is 6'4" throughout the interior and 6'7" on the aftdeck.

36' Grand Banks Accommodations

Salt Lick offers a forward stateroom with an island queen size berth and an ensuite head with a separate shower. The salon settee converts to a double size berth also.

36' Grand Banks Salon

The salon offers a wrap-around settee (Converts to a berth) and hi/lo table to port, side deck access door starboard forward, book-end cabinetry and lounge chairs to starboard, a sliding teak & glass door aft, opening side windows with curtains and wood blinds, teak parquet sole, opening center windshield and LED lighting. The wood blinds and soft goods were new in 2016.

36' Grand Banks Galley

The galley is located port forward in the salon.

36' Grand Banks Master Stateroom

The master stateroom forward offers an island queen size berth, nightstands, reading lights, 4 opening side windows with blinds and curtains, 3 overhead hatches, hanging locker, storage cabinets and drawers, full-length mirror, LED lighting, teak parquet sole and a shower to starboard and head to port.

36' Grand Banks Lower Helm

The lower helm is located starboard forward and offers a full console, helmseat, side deck access door and opening center windshield.

36' Grand Banks Flybridge

The flybridge offers a bimini, hinged mast, teak deck (re-seamed and re-bunged), stainless steel rails with canvas skirting, benchseats on each side facing forward and aft with storage underneath, full console forward with storage underneath and tender storage.

36' Grand Banks Aftdeck

The covered aftdeck offers a transom gate, re-seamed and re-bunged teak deck, stainless steel Magma BBQ grill, hot/cold fresh water shower, lazarette access, stainless steel & teak ladder to the flybridge, ice box port forward, stainless steel mooring line rack, outboard bracket and same-level access to each side deck.

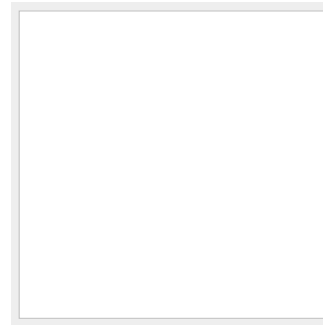
