The 84' Jarrett Bay, hull #60, stays true to its custom Carolina heritage, yet represents the future of sportfish performance and functionality. She is estimated to top out at speeds of 41 knots and cruise 35 knots. Jarrett Bay's proven modified-vee hull design uses steadfastly seaworthy, yet lightweight materials allowing her to be faster and more economical than most boats in her class. Powered by twin MTU diesels @ 2,600 hp each, she also features twin Seakeeper gyro stabilizers and twin 38kW Northern Lights generators, all which have been installed. The vessel carries 4,000 gallons of fuel, making travel to those faraway destinations easy. The sweeping mezzanine overhang gives way to a massive 265-sq. ft. cockpit, complete with two pressurized livewells with capacities up to 125 gallons. Hull #60 is built with a figured high gloss, cherry veneer throughout her interior and provides for five staterooms, each with their own private head, plus a day head conveniently located on the mail salon level. This is a very unique opportunity to own a truly custom, elite sportfisherman without the 3-4 year construction wait. Call today for complete pricing, equipment list and delivery schedule.

Overview

From her cold-molded fir and okume bones to her glossy Alexseal exterior finish, the 84' Jarrett Bay stays true to its custom Carolina heritage, yet represents the next evolution in sportfish performance and functionality. Thanks to prop tunnels and a low shaft angle, this yields increased speed and efficiency. The high-speed stainless rudders and struts and a bottom with no through-hull protrusions or fairings result in an incredibly fast and sleek running surface.

The intent of this build is to mirror her predecessor the 77 hull #56 which is showcased within the photos of this listing. The high-gloss cherry veneers throughout her five stateroom, six head layout is made of TriCel composite in both bulkheads and cabinetry keeping the weight to speed ratio at top performance levels without sacrificing durability in the roughest seas. The sweeping mezzanine overhang gives way to a massive 265-sq. ft. cockpit, complete with two pressurized live-wells with capacities up to 125 gallons.

She is powered by Twin 16V-2000 MTUs rated at 2,600hp and carries 4,000 gallons of fuel and is estimated to top out at a speed of 41 kts, with estimated cruising speed of 35 kts. With nearly 60 custom builds to date, Jarrett Bay designs their hulls, first and foremost, with performance in mind. Jarrett Bay's proven modified-vee hull design uses steadfastly seaworthy, lightweight materials allowing her to be faster than other similarly sized boats with equal or more horsepower, with significantly superior fuel economy compared to most boats in her class.

Salon

There are only a few cabinets built for the salon, so your opportunity is endless at this time.

- Rough opening for windows
- End tables are built, but not finished or installed
- A/C units are purchased, no ducting or connections installed or purchased

Galley

The galley is also able to be designed to your liking, as nothing has been built.

Crew Quarters

Turning aft down the companionway and across the full beam of the vessel, you will find the crew quarters which features an over/under berth, access to the engine room, and a full head.

- Hull Bottom: Cold molded construction consisting of three layers of 1/2" marine fir plywood on diagonals over fir stringers and glassed inside and out with two layers of 3408 tri-axial cloth with epoxy resin - complete
- Laminated douglas fir full length main engine stringers and keel complete
- Louvered side air intakes in, not totally installed
- Reinforced chine spray rails installed

Hardware & Miscellaneous

• All Interior cabinet hardware polished chrome - included, not installed

- Anchor locker bow deck, with anchor storage installed, hatch needs lid and gutter
- Water tank tank installed not connected


