




Cockpit with Swim Platform Gate








Engine Access through Salon Floor




















Master Stateroom Shower




Davit and Dinghy on Flybridge






Cockpit Ladder to Flybridge




Flybridge Helm




Flybridge Helm Covers




Bow Pulpit and Windlass




Buff and Wax of Hull in April 2017






Hull Buff and Wax in April 2017
