SPECIFICATIONS

Overview

I love this boat but I am buying a large boat so she is for sale. This Shamrock looks and feels like a much bigger boat.

The 260 Express marked a departure from earlier 26-footers from Shamrock in that she rides on an all-new hull with a wider beam and increased flare at the bow. Retained, however, is Shamrock's exclusive Keel-Drive system with its single- inboard power and protected running gear--a time-tested design based on a full length keel married to a modified-V hull. The added security of knowing that the Shamrock can survive a run-in with the bottom without damage is persuasive.

The cockpit of the 260 Express is set up for entertaining or fishing with an L-shaped settee on the bridge deck and a livewell, cutting board and sink plus shower built into the transom plus two large in-floor fish bones w/ power drains and a center equipment storage locker w/ power drain. Under the cockpit gunnels are pole holders fish hook holders, fresh water wash down fitting and accent lights.

The cabin, which is nicely finished, includes a small galley, good headroom, four opening ports and an enclosed head. Engine access, via a hatch in the bridge deck floor, hatch in cabin and hatch behind the bridge deck, give exceptional access to equipment. A stable fishing platform with good range, a standard 5.7-liter gas inboard will cruise the 260 Express at 17 knots and reach a top speed of around 26 knots.

Loaded boat in mint condition. Included 4-outriggers, 20-pole holders, canvas / aluminum cockpit cover, L-shaped settle w/ table at helm, flood lights, cockpit lights, enclosed head, galley w/ refrigerator, huge V-Berth and cabin, live bait well, cockpit fish lockers, dual fuel tanks, Garmin 741 color GPS/Fish finder, Single Mercruiser 5.7Horizon MPI w/straight shaft (keel drive) in perfect condition, protected rudder and propeller. Long keel for superior directional stability. Engine mounted low in bilge for superior stability and an open cockpit "fisherman" design.

This boat has a huge cockpit for its' size! Forward and aft engine access panels along with a large cockpit hatch. Additionally this Shamrock has a unique feature for unprecedented ease of access to the engine: The entire forward cockpit area over the engine can be unscrewed and slipped back over the aft cockpit for fantastic access to the engine, batteries, tanks, transmission, bonding systems, ground terminal plate, thru-hull fittings, bilge areas, etc.!!

Cockpit fresh water wash, cockpit shower, swim step, twin tackle centers, remote electric anchor windless & pulpit, four opening cabin ports plus overhead hatch, large removable cabin table, interior lighting, DC panel, galley storage locker, chain locker, dual batteries and charger, head holding tank and macerator/over board pump and

deck pump, dual auto bilge pumps, full Isinglass helm covers plus instrument cover, VHF radio, stereo, HALON system, NEW exhaust raises, new starter, NEW distributor cap and rotor, NEW plugs, NEW fuel filter. Hull, neck, bottom, rails, in mint condition. Super clean bilge.
