Accommodations

The J 120 is a proven benchmark throughout the industry. Not only an excellent platform by her performance aspects, but also a comfortable cruising interior with her Cherry interior and spacious layout. A beautiful warm interior is provided by the varnished Cherry bulkheads with cold molded trim, Cherry drawers and cabinet faces along with a Teak and Holly sole. Entering the saloon there is a full galley to Port with a storage area aft located under the cockpit seating. Across from the Galley is the Navigation area that has a large chart table with storage, vessel's electrical panels and navigation equipment. Forward is the matching settees newly upholstered Flag Blue Ultra-Suede with hinged backrest with additional storage behind, and built in book shelves above. In between the settees is a large drop leaf table. The head is forward and is accessible from the cabin as well as the Master. There is a manual shower, vanity with a molded in sink, additional storage below, and a large fixed mirror. The forward cabin has a private head entrance. There is a hanging locker along with a changing seat, bureau, and storage below. The Double V berth provides generous sized berths. The cabin sides are varnished Cherry sides. The Aft cabin is to Starboard and has a hanging locker, large single berth with a connected changing seat that has storage below.

The Galley is to the Port side as you enter the saloon

Gimbaled, Force 10 3 burner stove/oven w/S.S. safety bar & cutting board.

Highly polished stainless double sink recessed below 1/2" off-white Fountain head counter covering.

Vertical stainless grab post.

Molded 6.0 cu.ft. icebox with 4" foam insulation, dual lids, utility storage shelf and slider. (2) Dry goods storage areas w/ shelf & acrylic slider covers. Seafrust refrigeration motor driven and battery driven

Cup/Bowl & Plate storage on aft galley bulkhead.

Two utensil drawers

Pot storage cabinet with mid-height shelf below drawers.

Laminated cold molded fiddles.

Additional pot and pan storage under oven.

Trash storage under sink w/flip lid access.

Cabinet for cleaning supplies under sink.

Carbon Fiber Mast Two Harken 48.2 STA (selftailing) primary winches.

Four Harken 44.2 STA halyard & mainsheet winches.

Two 10" SpeedGrip and two 8" B8AL aluminum lockin winch handles with three PVC handle holders.

2:1 Mainsheet system of Harken Black Magic Blocks with three 75 mm leading to cheeks to P&S mainsheet winches.

Harken adjustable mainsheet traveler with 4:1 purchase Harken clear anodized jib & genoa tracks & endstops Harken Black Magic checkstay blocks system including

Harken Black Magic 75 mm double footblocks outboard of cockpit for checkstay tails & spin sheets. 150 cams near primaries for spin. sheets when not in use.

Disappearing checkstay system with three Harken bullets, and shock cord.

Harken spinnaker sheet blocks on Wichard 6544 Ubolts fwd. of stern pulpit legs.

Roller furling control line w foredeck block, SS lined bullseyes and Harken cam cleat w cam fairlead.

Five Bomar aluminum framed cabin opening ports and one fixed port on cabin sides and three Bomar cockpit opening ports.

Lexan companionway drop board with nylon storage rack in cockpit locker.

Double 5/32" coated lifelines & tapered stainless stanchions w custom bases, double SS bow & stern rails, and stern gate.

Three helmsman side & centerline seat cushions. Hall Spars 6061T6 tapered aluminum performance mast section with double airfoil spreaders, finished in offwhite Awlgrip, w-painted black bands, steaming light, internal wire conduit and predrilled head ventilation holes.

Mast fitted with single climbing step and two CL219 clamcleats for temporary cleating of halyards when hoisting sails alone.

Hall Spars boom w welded end fittings, 8:1 internal outhaul purchase system, mainsail reef sheaves, mainsheet bail, and vang lug. Finished in offwhite Awlgrip w painted black band.

Retractable carbon fiber JSprit extendable to 7' beyond bow w molded GRP end caps.
