Colours hull gelcoat white/stripes gelcoat dark blue 7344

Composite mast step with movable shoe

Stainless steel chainplate deck fittings

Standard one design keel, templates control to tolerance 0

Antimony alloyed lead bulb and fin with upper flange recessed into hull

Fin bolted to hull with high tensile steel bolts. Deep floors inside

400 kg weight adjustment by removable lead pigs of 50 kg each inside bulb

Foam filled rudder with carbon/epoxy stock

Aluminium quadrant. Vectran cable steering with roller bearing sheaves

White Anti-fouling below waterline

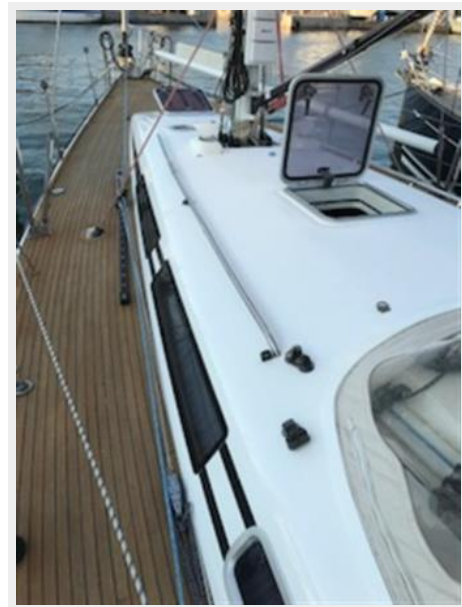
