- Custom set of movable boarding steps
- Varnished teak aft house bulkhead
- Varnished teak cabinets port and starboard housing three refrigeration units, bbq grill, large chipped ice machine and cooler, and tackle storage
- Double set of split opening teak steps up to salon and down to engine room
- Teak cockpit sole with waterways outboard
- Custom fighting chair on offset pedestal with rocket launchers

Bridge Deck

- Double sliding doors into enclosed pilothouse
- Dual fish chairs

- Custom tower to upper helm station with buggy top
- Molded in console pod with custom gauge and electronics mounts

VESSEL INTERIOR ACCOMMODATIONS:

Once on board you enter the main salon from the cockpit via a broad double set of stairs to the aft double sliding doors. Facing forward you immediately see a grand salon and galley area with forward facing windows bridging the realms of sportfish and luxury motor yacht.

Salon

- The salon is set up in two seating groupings port and starboard and an overall open plan through the galley and to expansive windows with a grand view up its long and sleek bow
- To port there are two built-in oversized lounge chairs with a combo cocktail/dining table, entertainment system and side cabinet
- Just forward of the port seating is a wet bar with stainless sink, bottle and glass storage and an icemaker
- To starboard is a wrap around couch with combo cocktail/dining table, as well as another built in oversized lounge chair facing aft
- A Flat screen TV is built into the face of the galley bar for salon viewing
- Midway along the starboard side is a bookshelf wrapping around outboard to a large buffet surface all in teak surfacing with large built in stainless steel freezers below
- Forward on the starboard side is a large chart flat area with pantry storage below, and large full view windows out the bow
- Electric window solar shades and black out curtains throughout salon and across aft bulkhead.
- LED overhead lighting throughout
- New neutral tone carpet and soft décor upgrades throughout salon

Galley

- To port is an open galley with all appliances below black granite countertops
- Jenn Air stove top with microwave on elevator lift hidden below countertop
- Double stainless sink and faucet outboard
- Dual undercounter stainless steel refrigerator units
- Garbage Disposal under sink
- Built in shelving, drawers and door units all around
- Electric window solar shades and black out curtains throughout
- LED overhead lighting throughout

Lower Hallway

- Leaving the salon you enter a staircase to lower hallway zone with new neutral tone carpet under foot and flanked by raised panel walls of solid stocks and veneers in washed oak finish
- Four staterooms open off the central hallway with a new washer/dryer set built in to port and forward a hidden stair hatch to an expansive bow mechanical/pantry hold with built in racking for expansive stores of both dry goods and other ships stores

Port Guest Stateroom

- Solid stock and veneered cabinetry throughout in washed oak
- Twin beds with upholstered head and side boards, with new, neutral tone décor throughout
- Hanging locker outboard
- Misc. storage drawers in nightstand and under beds
- Neutral tone carpet throughout
- LED overhead lighting
- Outboard portlight with screen and overhead escape skylight with privacy shade
- Full head with dual sinks, stone counter top and sole, enclosed shower with custom tile work
- Heated towel racks

Starboard Guest Stateroom

- Solid stock and veneered cabinetry throughout in washed oak
- Single bunk set outboard with new, neutral tone soft goods
- Hanging locker forward
- Dresser inboard with mirror above
- Neutral tone carpet
- LED overhead lighting
- Outboard portlight with screen and overhead escape skylight with privacy shade
- Full head with single sink, stone counter top and sole, enclosed shower with custom tile work
- Heated towel racks

Crew Stateroom

- Solid stock and veneered cabinetry throughout in washed oak
- Single bunk set outboard with new, neutral tone soft goods
- Hanging locker forward with drawers under
- Neutral tone carpet
- LED overhead lighting
- Full head with single sink, stone counter top and sole, enclosed shower with custom tile work

Master Stateroom

- Solid stock and veneered cabinetry throughout in washed oak
- New, neutral tone carpet, upholstery and softgoods

- King size bed with custom upholstered head and bunk rails
- Dual nightstands and outboard dressers
- Built-in leather upholstered settee aft and starboard
- Dual hanging locker outboard to port with drawers under
- Entertainment center aft including flat screen TV and storage below
- LED overhead lighting
- Outboard portlights with screens
- Suite sized head with large sink, stone counter tops, sole, and surround walls.
