DETAILED INFORMATION

Accommodations

- This unique, custom-designed motoryacht features an enclosed flybridge with a spacious "atrium" over the salon area lending the feeling of being in a huge yacht.
- An interior spiral staircase (stainless steel and wood) accesses the flybridge. An ergonomic helm is arrayed to wrap around the helmsman and provide easy access to the controls and navigation equipment.
- Also on the flybridge, is a sofa to port with a wetbar aft and a full beam balcony aft with bench seating. On the main deck, a well-appointed galley is found to port and up two steps are opposing settees (covered in fine Swedish leather) with hi-lo tables.
- Forward and down several steps is a large foyer leading to a master stateroom forward and guest staterooms aft -all with separate baths.
- The interior is beautifully finished with satin finished cherrywood and white vinyl. Door and bath hardware are polished stainless steel. New beige carpet has been installed throughout.
- Sleeps 7 in 3 cabins. The master stateroom features a centerline queen bed on a raised cherrywood platform with drawers. Closets are found on both sides. The port guest stateroom features a queen bed and the starboard guest stateroom features 3 single berths (outboard side are bunks). Access to the equipment room is through a watertight door in this room.
- All staterooms are finished in cherrywood and feature hanging closet/drawer spaces.
- There are two baths one in the master stateroom and one shared between the guest staterooms. Both baths feature a stall shower, dark blue CORIAN counter, teak/holly flooring and polished stainless hardware.

Galley

Features a spacious dark blue CORIAN countertop with a double stainless sink. Gloss teak/holly flooring. A slide-out bottle and glass cabinet is at the end of the counter.

Hull and Deck Equipment

- The hull is painted flag blue while the topside is off-white gelcoat.
- Wide, walkaround non-skid decks with high stainless steel rails make it easy to get around her.
- The foredeck features a large sunpad.
- The aft deck features a large, built-in settee with a portable, hinging teak table.
- This area and the swim platform is covered in teak (excellent condition). The swim platform features removable stainless hoops when the platform is not in use supporting the tender. Twin gates protect access to the swim platform.

- Maxwell 3500 windlass with galvanized chain and anchor (concealed under foredeck) with remote control/counter (helm)
- Maxwell aft capstans

Engine Room & Mechanical Equipment

Access the engine room from the aft deck. The low hour engines are V-drives with hinging deck access above, and feature underwater exhausts (clean, quiet operation) Another equipment room with the 3 fuel tanks

(stainless steel, cross-connected and open to each other for easy fueling) and miscellaneous equipment is forward and behind the starboard guest cabin.
