DETAILED INFORMATION

Great Harbour N-37 Overview

Young America is a Great Harbour N-37 with a unique open interior layout consisting of a dinette/office opposite the galley and flexible open space in the salon. At the helm, the wheel has been customized to allow the Captain to sit comfortably with his/her knees under the wheel. In addition to the standard equipment that makes a Great Harbour a comfortable cruiser or live-aboard, the current (original) owners have added 3-zone ITR hydronic diesel heating, factory installed Marine Lightning Protection (see more information under Fire and Safety Equipment), a 12' aluminum Duroboat tender with Lehr propane motor, mounted on an easy to launch stern davit, and other customized conveniences. Great Harbours are unsinkable and versatile cruisers with their shallow draft, low air draft, and large tankages. With generous safe and secure walk around decks, substantial railings, household appliances, and exceptional cruising range in a boat this size, Young America is a great choice for cruising the Great Loop, inland rivers, and the Caibbean. In fact, one cruised to Hawaii from Florida.

Great Harbour N-37 Construction Features

Great Harbour N-37 Walkthrough

The Great Harbour can be easily boarded through gates on three decks: the foredeck and mid-ship as well as the swim platform, allowing for entry through the aft or starboard door. The aft door leads into the salon with windows all around, an L-shaped seating/dining area to port with hi-low table. To starboard is open flexible space. Forward of the salon to port is the navigation station and the helm to starboard. A few steps down, the companionway leads to a dinette/office space to port, with a door access into the engine room. The U-shaped galley is starboard. Continuing down the

companionway, the head is to port and the vented combo washer/dryer to starboard. The master stateroom with island standard queen is located in the bow.

Great Harbour N-37 Salon

The open bright salon is surrounded by screened windows offering great visibility along with ventilation. Young America's salon is unique in Great Harbour N-37's in that it has open space (no built in furniture) on most of the starboard side. The current owners use customized director's chairs (included) for driving the boat and seating that can be moved for use at the dining table. Port side there is an L-shaped seating area with high/low table that converts to a gueen berth.

- Helm station can open to provide complete access to the main electrical panel and distribution system
- Storage behind glass helm; panel lowers for easy access to wiring
- Custom helm console with slanted wheel (so knees can fit under wheel)
- Nav table with fiddle rail and lifting table lid for chart storage
- Nav bench seat with file storage under seat
- Cellular shades on forward pilothouse windows
- Wood blinds on salon windows
- High-low dining table with two fold out leaves will seat six
- L-shaped settee with Ultra-leather upholstery, converts to queen berth (cushions stored in bo'sun's locker)
- Overhead lighting, reading lights, and oil lamp
- Clear View retracting insect screens on aft and starboard doors
- Two custom reinforced bar-height directors chairs fit comfortably at helm and dining table
- Thermostats for salon zone of the ITR diesel furnace and salon A/C
- Custom corner table starboard side with fan coil for 3 zone heat
- 2 red folding chairs (hanging on starboard bulkhead)
- Small bookcase aft
- Aft-hinged door to bo'sun's locker in teak and holly sole

Great Harbour N-37 Galley

The spacious U-shaped galley, starboard, offers household appliances and plenty of counter space and cherry cabinetry.

Great Harbour N-37 Dinette/Office

Young America is unique among Great Harbour N-37's. The starboard side galley is open to the port side dinette/office space. The space is designed with bench seating fore and aft with a table in between that lowers to become a double berth.

- 52" x 31" table can be lowered to make a double berth (extra cushions stored in Bo'sun's locker)
- 42" bench seat aft side with file drawer under seat

Great Harbour N-37 Bo'sun's Locker

The bo'sun's locker (or basement!) is reached through a hatch in the salon sole. Down a few steps is a lighted, dry storage area that runs the full width of the boat.


