- Most of the boat has air conditioning except the port aft cabin which shares a 16,000BTU with the main salon and port forward berth
- The port hull is for guests or family and features a large queen aft and a double berth forward
- The head is shared by these two cabins
- Both cabins provide plenty of storage areas and are fully air-conditioned

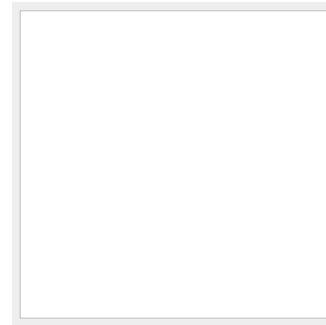
