DETAILED INFORMATION

Walkthrough

The Great Harbour N47 can be boarded at the swim platform or port and starboard gates at the aft deck and foredeck levels. The flybridge with upper helm is accessed by ladder from the aft deck. The aft cockpit door opens into the salon with L-shaped seating and hi-low coffee table to port and settee starboard. Seating has drawers and storage compartments below with additional cabinetry to starboard. The "basement," is accessed through a hatch in the salon sole and offers a large dry storage area with shelving the full width of the vessel. Moving forward, the navigator seat is to port with chart table and storage; starboard is the helm and door providing easy access to side deck. A few steps down and forward, the galley is starboard offering full size household appliances: side-by-side stainless steel GE Profile refrigerator/freezer, Kenyon four burner ceramic cooktop, KitchenAid microwave/convection oven, drawer dishwasher and Braun trash compactor. Plenty of Corian counter space with integrated double sink and mahogany cabinetry complete the condo style "kitchen." Opposite the galley, the dinette offers upholstered seating on each side of the large table, with storage available under the seats. Adjacent to the seating area is a storage cabinet and door to the stand-up engine room. Continuing forward to port is the multi-functional guest stateroom. Cabinetry and the built in separate washer and dryer are located on the aft wall. Forward is a settee that converts to a berth. Mounted on the port wall is a fold down desk/table. Across the companionway to starboard is the full guest head. Toward the bow, as you enter the master stateroom, to starboard is a generous Corian topped vanity with integrated sink and mirrored medicine cabinet above. To port is a desk and wall mounted TV. The centerline island queen berth is flanked by cabinetry on both sides with generous hanging lockers and drawers. There are also drawers under the berth. The ensuite head and shower are on the starboard side.

Accommodations

Christina Sea offers two staterooms. The master stateroom is located in the bow with a centerline island queen and ensuite head. The port guest stateroom offers a settee that converts to a 48"x75" berth. The full guest head is starboard opposite the guest stateroom.

Salon & Lower Helm

he salon is located through the aft cockpit door or the starboard side pilothouse door.

- L-shaped seating to port, with drawers below seat
- Settee to starboard, with drawers and storage area below seat

- Hanging storage locker starboard (40" tall x 10" wide)

The Bosun's locker is accessed through a hatch in the salon sole:
