Owner's Comments About Custom Features

Asymmetrical Salon was a \$12,646 additional charge.

- We did a total bright work interior finish with 13 coats of two part resin, for an almost indestructible lifetime finish.
- All of the teak on the boat was from a single old growth log.
- Upgraded from a YANMAR wing engine to a 70 hp LUGGER, an\$8,000 addition.
- Increased the fuel capacity by 150 gallons.
- Increased the holding tank from 60 gallons to 100 gallons.
- Went from all electric 10hp Thrusters an electric windlassto a complete abt hydraulic package of 25hp variable speedthrusters and a hydraulic windlass. This was a \$40,000 cost.
- Added a second inverter.
- Doubled to 2,000 Amp hour the house battery capacity. Added another and larger start batteries.
- Added a 55-gallon gas tank with hose and pump.
- Added storage and many cabinets.
- Up-graded the main Genset from 12kw to 20kw.
- Added the NUTONE vacuum system.
- Added two STIDD chairs in the Pilothouse and moved the standard pampanette chair to the flybridge, so we wouldhave (2) chairs at both helm areas.
- Added the hot water heat throughout the boat along withthe EVERHOT system and engine heat.
- Added (3) additional control stations to the Cockpitand both sides of the Portuguese Bridge.
- Had the Aft half of the Pilothouse ceiling raised about 8"


