DETAILED INFORMATION

Walkthrough

COCKPIT: The roomy cockpit with 360 degree seating for at 6 to 8 features an Yacht Specialties Wheel & Binnacle with a Ritchie Compass, engine throttle and gear shift port, starboard. A pedestal mounted cockpit table, stowed in the starboard bench locker, can be easily assembled when needed. The Westerbeke Engine control panel is found on the forward well wall, with warm up/start buttons on the cabin bulkhead. The canoe stern features a stainless steel railing and outboard engine mount. A Horse Shoe throwable pfd is attached on the starboard. Two built in storage compartments can be found port and starboard. Additional storage is provided by a Lazarette locker and in port and starboard under seat lockers. Two cockpit speakers can be found port and starboard. Two Bariant 32 self tailing winches are mounted port and starboard for jib trim, with additional Lewmar 25, Lewmar 40 and Bariant 23 winches mounted on the cabin top. Running rigging leads into the cockpit. Wind/speed/depth/autohelm instrumentation is mounted cabintop bulked. The cockpit is protected from the sun by a Bimini top. **TOPSIDES:** The deck is protected by Stainless Steel Stern and Bow Railings connected by dual lifelines running the length of the deck port and starboard; gates are found midship just forward of the cockpit, port and starboard. Hand Rails run along the cabin top, port and starboard. The Plow anchor is bow mounted with a windless deck mounted. The single spreader rig features Roller Furling, Spinnaker Track, installable Cutter Stay and cabin top mounted Main Sheet/Traveler. The standing rigging is stainless cable. Much of the running rigging was replaced in 2016. Cleats are found at the bow and stern, with an additional cleat mounted on the port cabin top track. **MAIN CABIN:** Descending the companionway from the cockpit, the aft cabin is found to port, with full length lockers to starboard. Moving forward the the galley is found to port and the nav station to starboard, followed by a seating area featuring straight bench seats, port and starboard. A fold down table is mounted on the forward bulkhead. There is a Teak & Holly Sole throughout. **GALLEY:** The U-Shaped Galley features a double stainless steel sink with hot and cold running water, a Hillerange oven/stove, and an icebox equipped with Alder Barbour refrigeration. Ample storage cabinets are provided throughout. **NAV STATION:** The forward facing nav station features a chart table, bench seat, radio & navigation electronics and the main electrical panel. **HEAD:** The head is found forward of the salon on the port side with full length locker opposite on starboard. The head, which converts to a shower, features a manual marine toilet, stainless steel sink w/hot & cold running water, cabinets & mirror. **FORWARD CABIN:** The forward cabin features a V-Berth bunk for 2. Under bunk storage, and full length lockers on the starboard side. **AFT CABIN:** The aft cabin is found on the port side. It features a a two person quarter berth, bench seat and small locker. Engine access is provided under and above the bench seat. **ENGINE COMPARTMENT:**

Accommodations

Sea Hawk provides sleeping accommodations for 6 people in 4 berths. - The aft stateroom sleeps 2 on a quarter berth. - The forward stateroom sleeps 2 on a v-berth. - The salon settees

sleep 2, one on the starboard settee and one on the port settee.

Salon

The classic and traditional salon is located amidships. - Teak & Holly sole - Straight port & starboard settees; seats 6-8; each converts to a single berth - Large storage areas behind each settee port & starboard - Water tanks below settees - Forward bulkhead mounted fold down table - Kelvin Hughes Clock; mounted on forward bulkhead starboard side - Kelvin Hughes Barometer & Thermometer; mounted on forward bulkhead port side - 2 Sony stereo speakers; forward bulkhead mounted, port & starboard - 1 Fan; 12 vdc; mounted on forward bulkhead starboard side - 1 Dorad ventilation port; overhead starboard side - 5 Opening ports; 2 port, 3 starboard - 2 Overhead opening hatches, 1 center forward, 1 over galley - 3 Overhead lights; 12 vdc - 1 Reading lamp; 12 vdc, mounted by starboard settee aft - Overhead grab rails, teak, port & starboard

Forward Cabin

The forward cabin features a split v-berth, with an insert to convert to a full v-berth. - Private cabin with teak & holly sole and an inward opening door - V-Berth, sleeps 2 - 1 full length locker starboard side - Shelf atop full length lockers - 1 Opening port - 1 Dorad ventilation port; overhead center - 1 Overhead opening hatch - 1 Overhead light - 2 Reading lamps

Aft Cabin

The aft cabin is found on the port side aft of the galley. - Private cabin with teak & holly sole and an inward opening door - Quarter berth; sleeps 2 - Small locker- Bench seat - Engine access is provided under and above the bench seat- 1 Overhead light; 12 vdc- 1 Reading lamp; 12 vdc- 1 Overhead hatch

Galley

Located in the port aft section of the salon, the galley features a U shaped design with the sink aft, stove along the port side and icebox forward. - Counter top running along aft bulkhead includes: - Double stainless steel sink with hot & cold running - Counter top locker right of sink - Under counter locker left of sink - 1 Locker and 3 drawers under sink - 2 Overhead mounted lockers above counter - Paper Towel holder, above sink - Knife holder above counter top locker - Counter top running between galley and salon includes: - Top access ice box, with Alder Barbour refrigeration 2008, serviced 2017 - Top mounted wine glass rack over counter - 1 120 vac Outlet above counter port side - HilleRange gimbaled 3 burner LPG stove/oven, between counter tops, port side - Locker under stove - Storage bins and lockers above stove and countertops, port side - 1 Overhead hatch - 1 Overhead light - 1 Opening Port -

Teak & Holly sole

Navigation Station

The nav station is located starboard aft in the salon. - Forward facing chart table - Bench seat with under seat storage locker - Under table lift top storage - 1 Under table locker - 2 Storage lockers, right of chart table and bench seat - Electrical panel, right aft of table - Instrument panel above table including: - iCOM IC-M422 VHF Marine Radio - iCOM IC-M710 MF/HF Marine Transceiver - Fusion MS-IP500 iPod Stereo Unit - 12 vac outlet - Garmin 2010C GPS Chart Plotter; mounted on chart table - 2009 - Bilge pump switch to right of electrical panel - Air Conditioning controls to right of electrical panel (NOTE: Inoperable, AC unit has been removed from vessel - Raytheon R10XX Raster Scan Radar, control panel mounted at companionway hatch - iCOM Command Mic II VHF Hand Held repeater, for mounting at helm - 2 Standard Horizon Floating HX100 Hand Held VHF Radios

Head

The combined head and shower stall is located on the port side forward of the salon with an outward opening folding door and a full locker opposite. The folding door doubles as a door between the salon and the head, to create an ensuite configuration with the forward cabin. - Jabsco manual marine head opposite door - 2014 - Stainless steel sink in countertop with hot & cold running water, along forward bulkhead - 1 under sink locker - 1 in counter locker - 3 Lockers running along port side above head and counter - 1 Opening port, counter sink & head - 1 Dorad ventilation port; overhead - 1 Overhead light; 12 vdc - 1 Mirror, mounted above sink - 1 Towel ring mounted right of sink - 1 Towel hook mounted right of sink - Toilet paper holder mounted inside of under sink locker door - Head area doubles as shower stall

Cockpit

The large and functional aft cockpit features. - 360 degree seating for bench seating for 6-8 passengers - Cockpit cushions - Installable post mounted cockpit table - Helm, center forward - 12 vdc receptacle, cockpit well forward, port side - 2 Outdoor stereo speakers; port & starboard - 2 Side pockets built into coaming - Cockpit Bimini Top - 2016

Helm

Center mounted Yacht Specialties pedestal helm with: - Stainless steel wheel - Ritchie Powerdamp binnacle compass - Transmission and Throttle mounted port and starboard side - Wheel brake, starboard side - iCOM Remote VHF radio hand unit plug, starboard cockpit side pocket - Autohelm Tri Data instrument (depth, speed, trip), cabin bulkhead mounted (inoperable) - Autohelm Wind instrument, cabin bulkhead mounted (inoperable) - Autohelm Auto Pilot control
