DETAILED INFORMATION

Accommodations

The interior accommodations include a forward master stateroom with a double V-berth which has three storage compartments underneath, a hanging locker, and small settee. Next to the forward cabin, aft, on the port side, in an ensuite head with shower. The main salon is aft where, to port, is a large dinette which converts to a queen-size berth (if needed), and a self-standing dining table with folding legs. Aft, to starboard, is the galley which features abundant cabinet space both above and below the counter tops. Further aft, to port, is the second head with shower which servers the two large aft private staterooms which are comfortably appointed and contain generous storage in each. Other interior features include:

- Fully automatic climate control (A/C and heat).
- Stereo system sound throughout.
- DC fans in each cabin.
- Custom cushions with specialty foam in master both cabins.
- Shower sump system in head/shower.
- Holding tank with macerator.
- Three fresh-water tanks with manifold to transfer water between tanks as needed (total 240 gallons)
- One, additional, 40 gallon water tank for R.O. water.

Galley

The galley offers a fully equipped area for food preparation and after-meal clean-up:

- Microwave oven.
- Refrigeration (less than three years old) with pump-out system.
- Three-burner stove with oven.
- Hot water system
- Large stainless steel sink.
- · Generous storage.
- Full inventory of utensils.

Electronics

A well equipped navigation suit includes:


