Accommodations

Salty Dog has a generous teak interior for a performance cruiser in her size. All the way forward is a comfortable "V" berth with four drawers underneath. There is also a sink and vanity combination with cabinets for storage, a mirror, and more storage under the sink. There is good light and ventilation. The cabin also has a opening window in the bulkhead and a door for privacy.

Aft is the main salon with port and starboard seating. A teak table with two opening leafs is perfect for entertaining below.

Numerous lockers and storage areas are outboard of the settees. Opening hatches and stainless steel port add ventilation and light.

A perfectly varnished teak and holly sole complete the picture.

To port aft is a opening chart table and electric panel for both 12v and 110v.

Across is the well designed galley.

We finish off with double aft cabin berth with numerous opening stainless steel ports for ventilation.

Aft of the chart table is a large head with marine toilet, mirror, vanity, sink, storage areas and ensuite shower stall.

The galley is located near the companionway and is well designed for cooking while underway or at anchor. Features include:

Construction details from Tartan

White, off-white or sand gelcoated deck with patterned, contrasting non-skid. Hand laminated sandwich composite of polyester resin, uni-directional "E" glass and end grain balsa core. All hardware installation points are solid glass backed with aluminum plate or FRP backing plates. Joined to hull using stainless steel fasteners that are drilled and tapped into aluminum backing plates molded into hull flange, spaced to meet ABS specification for offshore sailing yachts. Bonded with 3M 5200™ sealant.

38 Hp diesel with console mount controls and instrument panel. 38 gallon fuel capacity with remote gauge. Racor fuel filter/water separator. 16" Fixed 3-blade propeller on stainless shaft. Brass interior cabin dome lights and directional lights. Navigation lights. Electric sump pump. Electric bilge pump. 12 volt DC metered panel. 110 volt AC shorepower with distribution panel. 50 ft. shorepower cord. (2) 105 amp batteries with selector switch Electrical bonding system. UL approved stranded, tinned copper ABYC color coded wiring throughout Wiring conduits provided for future installations.

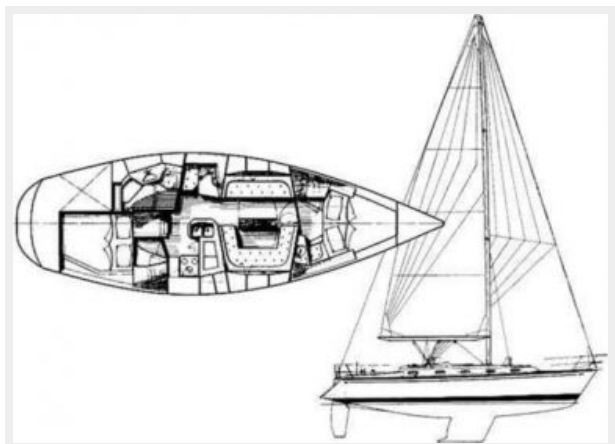
