# DETAILED INFORMATION

## Accommodations & Layout

---

- This Hunter Legend 37.5 has a spacious cockpit with easy access to the side decks and aft through the transom to the integral swim platform. Forward, the main companionway leads down to the main cabin with the galley to port and navigation station to starboard. Aft to starboard is the large head with curtain shower and access to the aft master stateroom. Just forward of the galley is the main salon with c-shaped settee to port, teak dinette table, and a settee to starboard. Forward of this cabin is the guest suite with a double V berth. This salon has a large c-shaped settee to port (converts to double berth), a teak dinette table (seats six), and a settee to starboard. There is a great amount of storage throughout this cabin in lockers, cabinets and under settees. Numerous windows provide great natural light, giving the cabin a spacious, open feeling. The cabin features teak joinery work, teak and holly sole, and beautifully upholstered settees. The navigation station is situated to Starboard aft and had a teak chart table with storage for all the navigation aids and equipment files.

- Master Stateroom: The master stateroom is entered aft to port. It features teak cabinetry, teak and holly sole, and a large double berth with cedar-lined cabinets. With an innerspring custom mattress and custom bedding. There is a wide upholstered seat to port, a vanity, and ample storage throughout. There is also a privacy door to the head, in effect creating a ensuite head.

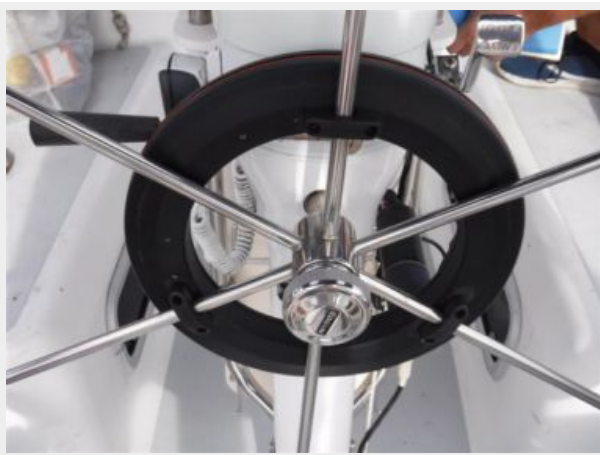
