As you enter from the mezzanine deck there is an L-Shaped sofa to port, ships electrical panel and entertainment center are to starboard. The lower profile galley is also to starboard with under counter refrigeration, and dinette to port. Moving below deck, the companionway is offset to port, the master stateroom is amidships to starboard with queen berth and private head. The port guest stateroom features upper/lower berths and adjacent head. The laundry is also located to port. The forward stateroom features upper and lower berths with access to the guest head.
