Features

Overall description Starting at the transom, there's a self-bailing fish box located just abaft the bench seat for two. A transom door is standard. The cabin is designed to sleep six, two in the forward V-berth, two in the dinette area that converts to a double berth, and two kids in the mid cabin. The head on the 290 is guite roomy with shower separated by a curtain, a Vacuflush toilet, mirrored vanity and sink. The 290 Amberjack can be fished hard and you don't have to sacrifice accommodations or cruising room either. She gets her stability from the 10 ½ foot beam and 11,300 lbs of displacement she carries. The galley comes complete with fiberglass countertops, a dual voltage refrigerator, two-burner electric stove, microwave and sink. In all, the 290 Amberjack is a nice mix between a fishing boat and a cruiser. It has the space for plenty of company and the fishing features for good offshore capability. Note: Vessel has a generator that has not been run in awhile. It only has 9 hours and will need extensive repair to get it running. The vessel asking price has been reduced to reflect the generator not being operable. 


