Overview

Occasionally a vessel comes along that is so exceptional and out of the ordinary that it makes one appreciate the tremendous ability of folk that set their mind above and about accomplishing something inconceivable to most.

Having taken seven years for her hardwood lumber consultant/owner to build in his spare time, "Sweet Dreams" is remarkable. For all practical purposes "Sweet Dreams" appears to be a new vessel that actually was completed in 2015. The craftsmanship that went into "Sweet Dreams" is outstanding.

Sam Devlin designed this vessel to be trailerable, which expands ones horizons to RV parks, campgrounds or any accessible body of water. This makes "Sweet Dreams" the perfect exploration vehicle allowing her owners to find out of the way spots on water or land that most can not visit.

"Sweet Dreams" creator/owner has followed Sam Devlin Designs since the 70's. Having been duly impressed with Sam Devlin's design techniques, he has followed through and built this beautiful little vessel. Over a 120 gal. of MAS epoxy was used in the construction of "Sweet Dreams".

All practicality aside, she's just plain "cute as a button"!

* New blue Awlgrip paint to blue hull sides Apr. 2019. * Achilles 8' dinghy with 2 hp. Suzuki outboard. * 2010 Yamaha 4 stroke 90 hp. reported less than 200 hrs. * Yamaha outboard purchased new in 2010, Commissioned 2015. * Aluminum 53 gal. fuel tank. * Mar Pro Screw on fuel filter/water separator. * Two foot swim step extension of the hull adding two feet to length. * Bay Star hydraulic steering. * Lewmar Pro 700 electric windlass. * 150' new 2019 chain and nylon rode. * Dry Bilge with no under water through hulls except transducers. * Low Pro LP 900s bilge pump. * One Group 27 start battery 2016. * Two Optima Blue Top gel cell House batteries 2016. * Two 4 amp hour each solar panels atop house. * Solar panel control box is 10 amp to house batteries. * All LED Lighting throughout. * Disk brakes on all four wheels of trailer. * Compression type brake activation (no electric brakes) for trailer. * C-Head Composting Toilet. Very easy to empty. * C-Head does not require pump-out or holding tank. * Wood trim is Douglas Fir. * Countertop is butcher block. * Flooring is cork. * This vessel can be towed with a standard sized pickup truck.

Brokers Observations

This is a very clean and well built vessel that is imminently practical for traveling and exploring new and out of the way places. The craftsmanship observed with the finished vessel (although not a surveyor) appears to be exceptional and time consuming (7 years) for the builder to bring to this level of finish, which is quite impressive.
