The GB 36 Classic has a two-stateroom, raised salon with straight galley layout and a flybridge.

Salon Details: Opening doors on both port and starboard side for ease of access to the bow and port to upper steering station. An I-shaped settee with a custom rounded top drop-leaf table, Bar Cabinet, Grand Banks Chair, clock and barometer, overhead lights replaced with warm white LED bulbs. All the window tracks have been replaced. New drapes installed (2019), with custom lined Sunbrella curtains throughout the salon.

Aft Stateroom Details: Double Berth to Starboard Single Berth to Port with nine (9) drawers chest of drawers aft. Marine Air, AC for the master stateroom and salon. Access to the aft deck. Ensuite Head with Separate Shower Stall. Raritan Marine Elegance Electric Head System

Forward Stateroom Details: V-Berth, Private head with Shower, Groco Type 5 Manual Head System, Storage in a Hanging Locker and Drawers, Opening ports with screens for Natural Ventilation, Lewmar Overhead Opening Hatch with screen.

- replaced most of the soundproofing on Genset enclosure (2016)
- new water pump and several hoses on Genset (2017)
- new electric fuel pump on Genset (2015)
- Exterior teak completely stripped (2015) and professionally maintained every year since.
- Standard deck maintenance- replaced screws and bungs as needed, and re-

seamed.

- Bottom soda blasted, blisters ground out and repaired, completely faired, multiple coats of Inter Protect, Bottom painted. (2015)
- All window tracks replaced, and some of the glass (2017)
- Props re-balanced. Some imperfections of tips repaired by bronze welding and repair. Now meet Class I tolerance for balance. (2016)
- Canvas serviced annually
- Bottom painted for 2019 season
- New zincs installed (2019)

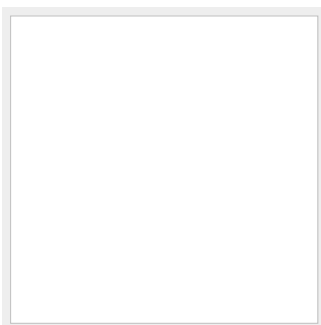
