

Walkthrough

Stepping from the dock into the cockpit you will see why this custom express is on every fisherman's wish list. There is more than enough room for everyone to enjoy. Taking a look around you will find a large transom fish box along with 2 In-deck fish boxes, Teak Fighting Chair, Freezer and Rigging Station w/ Fresh Water Available. Stepping up one step into the bridge deck you will notice a large bench seat to port and an L-shaped seat to starboard both with plenty of storage space underneath for all of your tackle and extras you will need. Continuing forward down 3 steps into the cabin space you will find her full galley complete with a two burner stove top, microwave and a full size upright refrigerator / freezer. Stepping slightly to Port you have a bench style sofa with rod storage underneath. Just forward is her Stateroom complete with over / under bunk and access the head compartment.


