Salon

The salon features U-shaped seating around the deluxe table dining table and settee seating to port. There are recessed handrails overhead for safe movement. The floors and trim finishes are in very good condition.

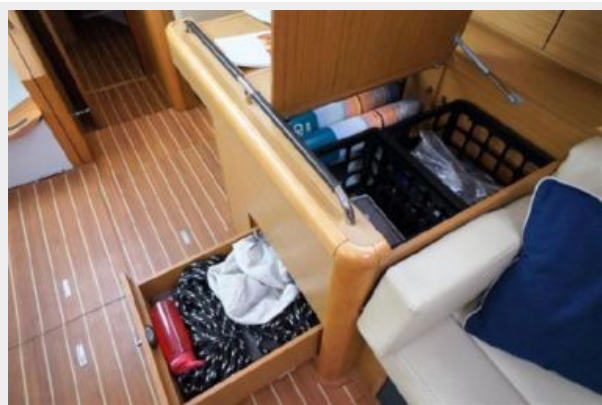

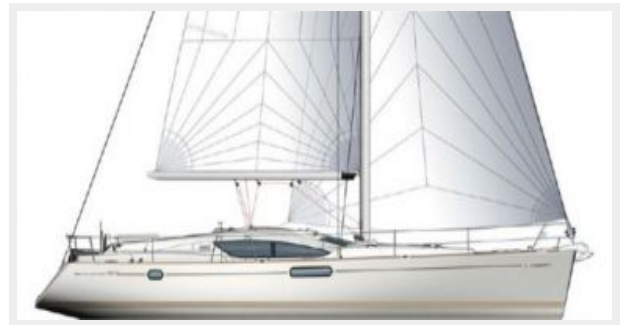
