The LAZY W is a 1985 model OCEAN ALEXANDER 43 Flush Aft Deck Trawler. Designed by Fred Monk, Jr. and produced by the very well-regarded Ocean Alexander Yachts facility in Taiwan from 1983 through 1986. These trawlers achieved a very good reputation for their outstanding sea-keeping abilities so typical of the Monk pedigree. Both the joinery and the overall construction is certainly one of the "best in the business" for this size & class of trawler yachts as well. The LAZY W is powered by twin FORD LEHMAN 120 HP diesels which will give her a cruise speed of 8 knots and with a combined fuel burn of approximately 4 GPH. She's spent most of her life in fresh water on Lake Michigan. Stored indoors for the Winters, when in this part of the world, she's in exceptionally good condition overall. Records are available for her maintenance over the years and the present Owners, over the course of some 6,000 miles logged since her purchase in the Spring of 2018, have been meticulous & diligent in her upkeep. The LAZY W is offered for brokerage sale as her Owners are opting to move up to a larger cruising power yacht. As an expedited sale is desired, the offered asking price is noted to be "aggressive". Qualified prospects are strongly urged to avail themselves of this opportunity to acquire "one of the best" at a most reasonable price.

Contact The LAZY W is currently in Maine .. and about 30 miles from the Canadian border! She'll be voyaging down to arrive in Portsmouth, RI by the end of the first week of September to facilitate her brokerage marketing efforts. The included YouTube video was taken in October of 2017 in Michigan and prior to the present Owner's purchase in May of 2018. Outside of the electronics upgrades and a different aft davit system, the LAZY W is essentially the same as portrayed here. Owner's Comments The LAZY W has traveled over 6,000 miles in the last 15 months so she's more than ready for sea and this has been well-proven during our voyaging! Throughout her cruise of the Great Lakes, the Erie Canal and the Eastern Seaboard from Maine to Florida, the LAZY W has been carefully maintained on an almost daily basis. She has never broken down or lost control even in a bad storm we encountered offshore. Her cruising speed is 8.3 knots at 1800 RPM and she got 2 nautical miles per gallon consistently. Her shallow draft (3'6") and seaworthiness made her go where and when other boats could not, and her stately Monk and Ocean Alexander pedigrees was admired by all. The Owner has happily achieved his dream of cruising the eastern US and is moving on to other items on his bucket-list.

Hull & Deck Hull The LAZY W has a hand laid-up fiberglass hull with no coring materials. She has a semi-displacement hull underbody and with a generous flared bow section for good sea-keeping ability and dry operations in a running sea.

Deck The Aft Deck is large for a 43' vessel and basically covers the entire Aft Cabin as the "Flush Aft Deck" models do. This area is accessed on port side via teak boarding steps & stainless steel rails. The Aft Deck is fiberglass w/ teak decking, has newer screen weather panels and a canvas Bimini Top with stainless steel supports. There is a ladder up to the Bridge forward, stainless steel w/ teak steps, a door to the Salon on

center and a starboard sidewet bar w/ a sink & storage cabinet. The LAZY W was produced with teak decking for the side decks & the aft & bridge deck areas. Her Survey of May, 2018 noted the overall condition to be "above-average".

BridgeThe Bridge seating is comprised of a swivel Helm Chair on center and port & starboard side "L"-shaped bench seat with storage below. The Bridge also has stainless steel railings, the fiberglass cowling, a Plexi venturi-type windscreens with protective stainless railings, teak trim and a newer Bimini top with a full enclosure.

Accommodations The LAZY W has the standard Ocean Alexander 43' Double Cabin layout with a double cabin layout on two levels with both forward and aft Heads. The interior decor has vinyl headliners, teak veneered paneling, teak cabinetry, teak parquet flooring throughout and Granite / CORIAN-style countertops. The Fore Cabin, Head, and Galley are located on the forward lower level with the Salon up at just below deck level, and the Aft Cabin / Master Stateroom and its own ensuite Head is located on the lower level aft.

Forward Cabin The Fore Cabin has a large V-berth & a hanging locker and storage cabinet on the port side aft. There is an overhead hatch, storage below the berths, a privacy door aft and an ensuite Head on the starboard side aft.

The main AC / DC distribution panels are located below the Helm Station to port. The steps down to the Aft Cabin are located starboard aft and to the Aft Deck on the port side aft.

Aft CabinAft is the Master Stateroom or Aft Cabin. The Aft Cabin has a large "island-style" double berth, a large hanging locker to starboard at the Companionway, port & starboard side hanging lockers & drawers, a vanity area to starboard aft and the ensuite Head located to port. The Head has a sink, a newer updated SEALAND Vac-u-Flush toilet, medicine/storage cabinets, and a fiberglass walk-in shower. There are newer ports and Granite / CORIAN-type trim is installed to port, starboard and aft.
