- Hull and its structural grid are infused in one operation
- Balsa Cored Hull
- Deck is constructed by a closed molding injection system
- The hull/deck joint is mechanically and chemically bonded
- Keel is a cast iron fin with torpedo shaped lead bulb hardened with antimony

- 63" diameter, double spoke, leather covered wheel (wheel well in cockpit sole)
