Comes with a custom steel cradle and fully framed canvas winter cover.

CONSTRUCTION

Hull constructed of hand-laid solid GRP bonded to a structural grid/hull liner of directional fiberglass/GRP for a strong, stiff, light composite. Vinylester hull barrier coat to resist osmotic blistering and zone specific stitchmat laminates for specific increased strength optimization.

Deck constructed of Cored GRP sandwich construction for stiffness, thermal and acoustic insulation and lighter weight. Solid fiberglass reinforcements in high load areas. Integral unidirectional GRP deck beams for added strength. Main bulkheads bonded 360° to the hull and deck for rigid torsional and compression strength.

STANDING RIGGING

- Deck stepped 9/10 fractionally rigged, classic, anodized aluminum mast
- Aft-swept spreaders
- Halyard blocks attached to mast step
- Roller furling mainsail, inhaul and outhaul line
- Stainless steel 1x19 cable (Forestay, capshrouds, intermediates, lower shrouds, twin backstays)
- (4) Chainplates for the shrouds
- Anodized aluminum boom for roller furling mast w/outhaul car

RUNNING RIGGING

- Running rigging is led to the cockpit;

 - genoa halyard w/jammer and cleat on mast
 - boom topping lift with cleat on mast
 - roller furling mainsail inhaul line
 - roller furling mainsail outhaul line
 - mainsheet
 - rigid boom vang with tackle

 - genoa roller furling line led along the toerail to a jammer

- (2) Side access hatches in the head compartment and aft cabin
- Fixed three-blade propeller
- Rotomolded fuel tank (34 gal) with electric gauge, located under the aft starboard berth
- Seawater strainer and diesel fuel filter
- Engine control panel with built-in key start and electric stop in the cockpit to starboard
- Ventilation – opening portholes

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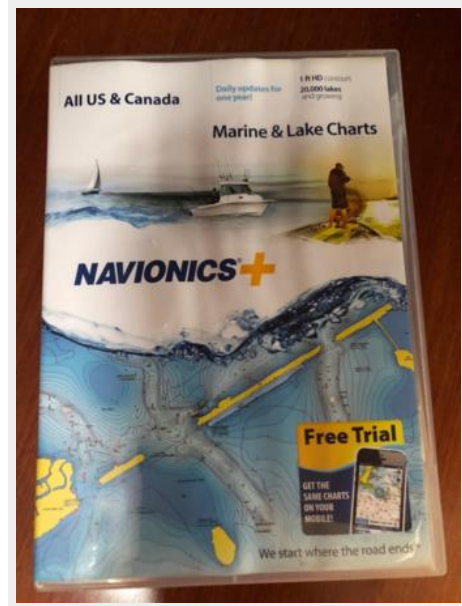
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
