There you will find a beautiful clear carbon fiber folding table with varnished fiddles. The table is flanked by two long settees. The pilothouse offers a panoramic view while

offering protection from the elements. COMPANIONWAY: The ladder going down is large and easily traversed either facing forward or backward. Handholds are plentiful. SALOON: The large and airy main saloon offers a table with seating for 8. GALLEY: To starboard of it, is the well equipped galley with plenty of storage space. NAVIGATION STATION: Aft of the galley is the charting station. All navigational aids are located here along with electrical monitoring. A comfortable pilot's seat with arm rests is securely fastened to the cabin sole. ALLEYWAY AFT: Behind the seat is the alley leading to the master stateroom. MASTER CABIN AFT: Entering the master suite, a center line queen island center line bed compliments the stateroom. The hulls are flanked with counter tops, drawers and a vanity to port. Forward of the vanity is the master head. The countertop is blue Corian, MASTER HEAD: The Master head is very large. The TECHMA freshwater toilet assures no smells. This room has a separate walk in shower with lexan door. FORWARD: GUEST CABIN: Forward of the galley and the mast, are the other two staterooms. One features a queen bed with ensuite head and the other has two single berths (over & under) and ensuite head as well. A watertight bulkhead separates this area from the main saloon. Early in the life of the boat, Dr. Paris will participate in some short-handed racing and then attempt to set or break non-stop records as the oldest person to solo circumnavigate and then include the shortest solo circumnavigation from St Augustine, FL, and Bermuda. Dr. Paris intends to tackle this feat without use of fossil fuels, relying on solar panels, wind generators and hydro-generators for his circumnavigation beginning late 2013. These technologies will also reduce reliance on generators in its later cruising life. The general approach has been to use modern design concepts and construction methods to produce a conservative but fast and sea kindly vessel that can cover oceans quickly and provide a comfortable and spacious live aboard experience. A lifting keel provides reasonable draft for entering anchorages. High performance and safety while sailing are achieved with the deep keel, hybrid Carbon, Kevlar and Glass fiber sandwich construction, relatively narrow waterline beam, long waterline length and a moderate amount of water ballast tucked into the generous beam at deck. The carbon spar cutter rig, permanent roller furling genoa and staysail, plus slab reefing mainsail will make sail handling straight forward, while furling reacher and asymmetric spinnaker can be set from the retractable bowsprit for speed and nice balance in lighter reaching and downwind conditions. The layout features sail controls led to a central cockpit steering position for ease of short-handed sailing, significant on deck shelter in a "hard" dodger over the companionway and cockpit seating, plus an integrated deployable soft dodger to further shelter the steering station. The very spacious interior features a huge aft owners stateroom, generous center salon, galley and chart table area, plus two private cabins forward. All appliances are electric, with energy abundance provided via a 17 Kw/hr Lithium battery pack and a 11 Kw generator during the cruising phase to minimize charging time when alternative generation is not available.

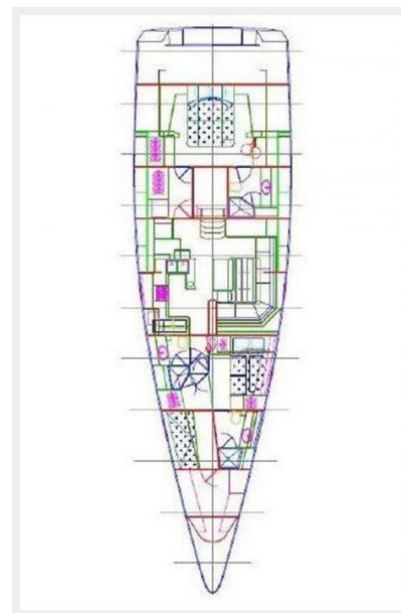

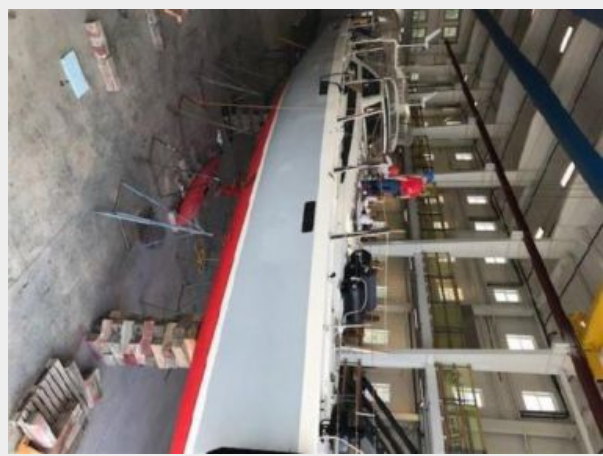
