Overview - features

A pro-rigged fishing machine with a huge self-bailing cockpit, generous fishing elbow room throughout, and rod holders everywhere. A beautiful gap tower, updated electronics including recent night vision camera and a KVH TV dome. This is a go-anywhere boat which cruises easily at 40 knots with a 24.5 degree bottom that handles the sea state.

- Large Center Console with quality enclosure and comfortable Helm Seats
- Cockpit rear facing seat with Cool box / Freezer beneath
- Multiple Live Wells and Tuna Tubes with Hooker pump box
- Custom 6-rod Rocket Launcher with tray
- Huge Fish Boxes forward and aft
- Air-conditioned cabin under Console with head
- Double berth plus storage space and SAT TV
- Insulated boxes to keep provisions when traveling
- Underwater lights

Cabin, beneath console and front lounge seat

- Portside opening door with lock
- 2 step ladder with white poly treads down to SeaDek teak-look sole, grab railing
- MarineAir reverse-cycle air-conditioning
- Black granite-look Corian counter-top with backsplash and circular stainless steel sink
- Faucet wand is retractable to be capable of shower with drain in sole
- Magic Chef microwave oven
- White fiberglass finished cabinet and walls
- Toilet hides away beneath hinged counter-top and opening cabinet
- Hideway storage cubby beneath counter-top
- Extractor exhaust fan, LED overhead dome lighting
- Visio LCD color TV ('17)
- Double berth area with canvas covered cushion and pillows
- storage shelves to either side of berth with SeaDek and padded bolsters above
- GFCI 110v outlet, Radial battery switches, Main electrical breaker panels
- High water bilge alarm panel, CO2 detector/alarm

- Carbon/Kevlar strengthened fiberglass hull construction
- Carbon strengthened hatch lids with stainless latches
- Stainless steel Tow Eye, 2017
- Sky-Blue hull color with white boot pinstripe and blue bottom-paint (2020)
- White Yamaha motors, white poly rubrail with stainless strike plate
- White deck and white cushions with blue piping accents on bolsters
- Brushed aluminum pipe Bausch/American Gap tuna tower (50" gap) with fiberglass hardtop, tower floor, and tower shade
- 3-sided polycarbonate enclosure around console, 2017
- In front of the console is a large lounge/sun pad that hinges open with gas ram assist to a large insulated storage box/cooler
- Large coaming pads around entire deck, 2017
- White powder-coated flush safety railing above coaming pads forward of helm
- 3 LeBroc Billfish bucket seats with flip-up bolsters and arm-rests, 2017
- Cockpit aft-facing bench seat on backside of helmseat console with Cool box /Freezer beneath the seat and tackle storage compartments above and on side
- Top of seat console has 4 rod holders and 7 drink holders
- Forward deck has an 80-gallon underdeck livewell with clear opening panel in center of deck hatch
- Forward underdeck mascerated fish box, center
- Forward port and starboard underdeck storage or fish boxes, 6+ feet long each
- 55 gallon livewell in top of starboard transom with clear plexi cover
- Portside livewell converted to Tuna Tubes (4), 2020
- Hooker pump box, 2020
- Cockpit under-deck insulated fish boxes, port and starboard

- Rupp Z-30 Top Gun radial outriggers, with (2017) GemLux collapsible carbon poles
- White Custom pedestal rocket launcher with 6 rod holders, 7 drink holders, and magnetic rigging tray
- Electric reel plugs (6) under the gunwales
- Center walk-through transom door with secure stainless latch
- Retractable swim ladders (fold-out steps) from each corner of transom
- Bow top-opening anchor hatch with storage for two anchors and securing tabs
- Fortress anchor and nylon rode
- Flush mounted stainless steel pop-up cleats, 2 forward, 2 aft, 4 spring
- Fresh and Salt water washdown hoses with spray nozzles mid-ship under gunwales on auto-retract reels
- SeaDek (teak-look) at helm console floor and footrest, on tower helm floor, and on top of helm console with cutouts to contain items rolling off
- Fore and aft deck LED spreader lights, mounted in hardtop
- Port and starboard LED flood lights, mounted under hardtop sides
- Florescent light and map light under hardtop
- 4 Underwater LED lights, 2 Lumitec, 2 Lumishore, 2020
- 32 gunwale mounted flush rod holders and 6 drink holders
- 14 storage rod holders along starboard side of console and 2 drink holders for forward lounge seat
- 6 storage rod holders along port side of console and 2 drink holders for forward lounge seat
- 4 drink holders flush mounted in the helm console face
- Aft cockpit corner scuppers with drain trough
- Canvas covers for tower helm, forward bench lounge, and helm console seating, 2017

- Samplex DC-AC power inverter (runs cabin Air or microwave from batteries)
- Freshwater pressure house water-pump

- Two sets of Stainless props, PowerTech 20" pitch and Merc Rev4 21" pitch (2020)
- Optimus electric/hydraulic steering

New to the market, here is a beautifully rigged 45' SeaHunter with quad 350hp white Yamaha 4-strokes and a Bausch/American tower with 50" gap. 2017-'18 electronics update included 3 new 16" Garmin black glass displays and radar scanner, Garmin autopilot, and KVH sat TV dome. Earlier this year the boat got a FLIR night vision camera and custom pump box with Tuna Tubes. Cabin under the center console has air-conditioning, a double berth, and TV. There is even a freezer compartment under the rear-facing cockpit bench seat. Quad-white Yamahas have had their 1000 hour service and run great - 63 mph at WOT when needed (thanks to new props) or huge range (600 miles) when throttled back. This 12-foot beam center-console is a truly special fishing machine.
