- Engine Room: The sound package consists of barriers and absorptive insulation in addition to vibration/isolation mounting of equipment, piping and wiring that may transmit noise and noise attenuating/watertight door
- Sound Down absorptive insulation
- Various insulation mounts
- Accommodation Sound Dampening: Noise transmission between spaces in the accommodation areas is via sound 'tight' construction, acoustic fill in double wall bulkheads, and isolation mounting of equipment and piping that may transmit vibration
- Whisper Walls 3M Thinsulate acoustic fill
- Sylomer insolation material

Systems

Diesel Fuel System:

- Approximately 5,500 gallons (US) of diesel in one tank separated into three compartments with a transfer system including a pump, meter and distribution manifold. All diesel consumers draw from the center compartment (Day Tank). During normal operations fuel is transferred to the day tank via the transfer pump. Fueling process is via either of two deck fill locations amidships, port or starboard side. Tank is vented to atmosphere on both sides of the vessel. Tank level monitoring is via electronic sensor and display with high/low level alarms. Tank is all aluminum, welded construction with internal baffles and three divided areas
- Fuel transfer pump will have a flow meter and timer

- One dual Sea Pro 8 fuel filter with isolation valve for each main
- One Dual Racor 75/500 fuel filter for each generator
- Fuel gauge sight tubes located in Engine Room and InteliSea monitoring
- ¼" 5086 alloy aluminum separated tank with dual fills and standard vents, InteliSea monitoring and sight tube level indicators

Gasoline Fuel System:

- The gasoline system consists of a tank, an air diaphragm pump, and hose with nozzle to transfer the gas. The hose, nozzle and pump, along with the tank fill are located under the hatch centered on the Swim Step deck
- Aluminum 100 gallon tank
- Air diaphragm pump

Lube Oil System:

- The vessels main engines and generators can be serviced utilizing and onboard lube oil change system. A new oil tank and a used oil tank are fitted in the Engine Room. The new oil tank can be filled via a 1 ¹/₂" deck fitting amidships on the starboard side. The quick connect hose and portable pump are used to transfer lube oil to/from locations
- Located in the Engine Room bilge area
- Lube Oil Tank New: Aluminum, 60 gallon
- Lube Oil Tank Used: Aluminum, 60 gallon
- Portable and stowed pump below the starboard generator
- Stainless quick connects fittings

Stabilization System:

- Stabilization while underway is provided by a pair of fins located approximately amidships and powered hydraulically by an engine driven hydraulic pump. Control is by modern digital system located in the Pilothouse
- Naiad Model#353 with 12 sq. ft. fins, single station control, with oil level warning, unloading valve kits and dual pumps with gauge kits

Air Conditioning System:

- The interior of the vessel is kept at a constant temperature through the use of a seawater cooled reverse cycle, treated water HVAC system. The capacity is 24 tons and is distributed throughout the vessel via individual room air handlers of various sizes and BTU ratings. There is one keypad for the two air handlers in the Master Stateroom and two for the four air handlers that serve the Salon; all other air handlers are each controlled by a separate keypad
- Salon, Galley, dining area, Pilothouse and all staterooms are air-conditioned.
- Master Stateroom, Salon, Galley, Pilothouse, and Guest Staterooms have linear diffusers for even temperature control

- Master & Guest Staterooms have chill chaser units
- Eight exhaust fans, two in the VIP head and one in the other heads
- 4 compressors and heating pump, independent seawater intake
- 230V-1PH-60Hz, 24 ton chiller
- 230V-1PH-60Hz, various BTU as required by volume being treated, utilizing variable speed hi static DC blowers
- Make up air for cycling air through the vessel interior

Bilge System:

- System consists of 5 remote-mounted bilge float switches and InteliSea alarms on all float switches
- Fixed bilge pump system includes two electric 230 VAC pumps with 1 ½" PVC lines to each major compartment with check valves, strainers, and priming system

Freshwater System:

- The system is comprised of multiple divided and baffled fresh water tanks, two AC supply pumps, suction supply, service and distribution manifolds, two reverse osmosis watermakers, and associated valves, filters, expansion tanks, regulators and gauges
- Freshwater wash downs with quick connects are located on all decks
- Two 220 VAC pumps and one 24 VDC backup pressure pump with tank
- Water tanks are aluminum with interior epoxy coating and an approximate tank capacity of 1,000 gallons. InteliSea monitoring system and sight tube level indicators
- Two Sea Recovery SRC AWC 1400-2 watermakers (2,800 gallons per day total)
- 5 micron sediment water filters with UV sterilization light
- 2 Dual element, fast recovery water heaters, one 80 gallon and one 38 gallon

Waste Water System

- Black and Gray water is routed to an FRP Tank
- A certified Marine Sanitation Device (MSD) is installed for treatment of all wastewater Tank level monitoring is via electronic sensor and display with level alarms and all tanks are vented at the boot stripe
- Discharge is via MSD or direct overboard via diaphragm pump
- Dockside connection is located just aft of the starboard fuel fill
- High capacity pumps solids handling AC diaphragm type
- Headhunter MSD treatment with PLC touch screen and Auto-Clor treats black and gray water
- Tank is composite with an inspection hatch
- Tank is electronically monitored and has an approximate capacity of 600 gallons
- Two approximately 15 gallon gray water boxes fitted with screens; also, supply and discharge lines for all showers

• Forward & aft sump tank will have sump pumps and 24 VDC backup pumps

Compressed Air System

- The vessel has a compressed air system for powering the ship's whistle and gasoline dispensing pump, as well as for use the machinery spaces for air powered tools
- Compressed air lines run to the Bow and the Swim Step
- SpeedAire 3 hp compressor with 20 gallon tank
- 18' self coiling air hose with quick-disconnect

Mooring and Anchoring

- Dual Poole style 300 lb. polished stainless steel anchors with polished stainless steel anchor plates
