DETAILED INFORMATION

SPECIFICATION

The Swan 651 was conceived as a fast cruising yacht. Originally named WHITE SWAN this yacht was built for an experienced owner and delivered in the spring of 1983. She has a powerful sloop rig but for ease of handling she has a Reckmann mast with hydraulic furling and hydraulic outhaul for the mainsail, also hydraulic furling headstay and powered sheet winches.

Always well maintained, lightly used, never chartered, WHITE SWAN remained in her original ownership until summer 1999. The yacht was refitted during 1997/98. The main items of the refit included - a new teak laid deck, simplified deck layout and complete rig overhaul. The whole yacht was subject to a thorough inspection, with servicing, refitting or replacing of any parts as deemed necessary. Following her change of ownership in 1999 the yacht underwent further improvement and the addition of much new equipment – including, air conditioning, water maker (not operated in this ownership and condition unknown), Inmarsat system, computer and radios. WHITE SWAN then sailed to the Caribbean and Florida before returning to Palma. In the summer of 2001 she changed hands again and was renamed ASTERI. The yacht underwent further refurbishing, including new cabin sole boards, new upholstery and other items. She subsequently crossed again to the Caribbean, returning to Europe in the summer of 2002 and was subsequently lightly used in the UK. In this ownership she has cruised in Scandinavia and proved herself to be a perfect family cruising yacht. She has been substantially improved and updated including the fitting of a new generator, a new enclosure system for the aft cockpit and upgrade or service of all the main systems as well as repaint and overhaul of the rig. She has been returned to the South Coast of the UK to be offered for sale. 2010 has seen further upgrades with a new electric bow thruster which makes handling ASTERI very easy shorthanded, full re-varnish of the interior, new refrigeration, new cream leather upholstery and new mattresses in all the cabins.

- Bar unit forward of settee.

From saloon a door way leads to:

Two guest cabins:

- Each fitted out with upper and lower berths.
- Hanging locker.

- Hinged table unit.

Port cabin:

- Private toilet / shower area forward.

Starboard cabin:

- Adjoining toilet / shower area forward, from which a door leads to the Fo'c'sle with two teak hinged berth.
- Ladder up to deck via large sliding hatch.

- Sony stereo cassette player in aft cabin.
- Sony 10 player CD player at chart table with speaker switches (saloon and/or cockpit) 2006.
- Bose sound system 2006.
- Sony 32" LCD digital flat screen TV 2007.

Rig:

- Triple spreader sloop rig. I = 26.80m.
- Nautor / Reckmann mast of aluminium alloy. Reckmann boom, hauled, repainted and fully serviced 2006.
- Rod rigging. Running backstays. Shroud rollers.
- Reckmann in mast hydraulic drive furling mainsail system, controls at helm.
- Reckmann hydraulic furling headstay. All hydraulics rebuilt at manufacturers in 2006.
- Furlex manual furling for staysail 2006.
- Navtec hydraulic tensioners for backstay, vang, baby-stay and inner stay with main control panel on forward side of pedestal and separate gauges to port of helm.
- Spinnaker pole, stows on mast.
- Halyards upgraded as necessary, new spinnaker halyards in Dyneema 2009.

Lewmar Winches:

- Primary sheet winches 2 x 98 with "coffee grinder" system.
- Secondary sheet winches 2 x 70 hydraulic drive.

- Mainsheet winch 1 x 65 ST (self tailing) - spare function on hydraulic pack to convert this to hydraulic at later date if required.
- 2 x 44 ST - mainsheet traveller. 2 x 65 CST and 2 x 55 CST at mast – halyards.

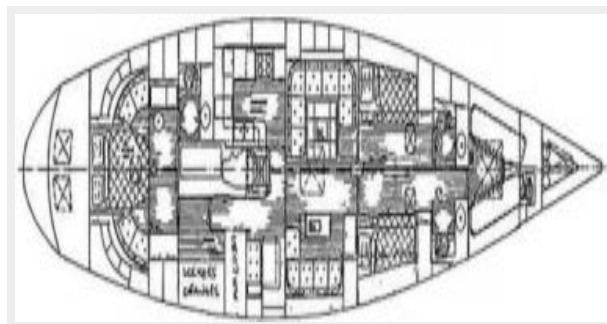
