ACCOMMODATIONS AND LAYOUT:

The FOUR SEA SONS features the classic 41' Hatteras layout with the master stateroom forward with a walk-around queen berth, plenty of drawer and hanging storage, deck access hatch, and a private access to the port side head. This head has the glass-enclosed shower, Vaccu Flush head, cultured marble counter top, and a large lighted vanity. Directly to starboard is the guest stateroom with upper and lower berths, hanging locker and drawer storage below the lower berth. Aft and up three steps is the salon with the galley along the port bulkhead and an L-shaped sofa to starboard and aft. Access to the cockpit is via a swing door. The decor is beige carpet throughout (new 6/07), teak walls and trim, gray sofa, light gray bunk covers and beige and white striped curtains.

GALLEY/LAUNDRY:

The galley is up in the salon and along the port wall, Upright refrigerator/freezer, Princess 3 burner electric stove and oven, Single stainless steel sink, Teak Hi/Lo table, Panasonic microwave oven, Beige formica cabinetry and counter tops, 20 gallon electric water heater, Pressure and dockside water system.

DECK/HULL:

Danforth anchor, Bow pulpit and rails, Coast Guard approved safety package, Fiberglass deck, Freshwater and salt deck wash down system, Fenders and lines, Navigation lights, Murray Products fiberglass helm and companion chairs, 4-sided enclosure with 8 zip outs (new in 2006), 4 stainless steel fender racks on bow rail, Transom door and gate, Maxwell Nilsson rope windlass, Cockpit Sunshade, Covers for teak bridge and cockpit steps.

4 batteries with 4000 amp hours, Battery parallel switch, Automatic and manual 45-amp battery charger, Onan 8 KW generator with 2267 hours, 220-volt 50-amp shore power cord, 12-volt DC electrical system, 110-volt and 220-volt AC electrical system.
