- Salon layout on starboard side (from bow to aft): install std armchair, install std low table, sofa with backrest and armrests until extreme aft (no aft low table), armchair included to the sofa, with backrest and without armchair
- Cabinet on portside on aft of the sofa in salon: same height as the sofa, divided into two vertical sections, one dedicated as glass holder, the other one dedicated as bottle holder
- Close with a door the cabinet placed on bow portside of the salon
- Provide storage on bow in the galley, between the fridge and outboard side, above the icemaker
- Delete std table and armchairs on starboard side of the master cabin and install one cabinet in cherry wood with shelves and closed by doors
- Sanded glass door between WC and sinks in the master head
- Little shower beside the WC in the master head
- Little shower beside the WC in the VIP head
- Crew quarters

Deck Equipment

- One 65 Kg Poolanker anchor in steel
- 75m steel chains (12mm in diameter)
- One 2000W, 24V, anchor winch on bow inside a proper storage
- Two 1200W, 24V, mooring winches in aft cockpit
- Six cleats in total (two on aft, two amidship and two on bow)
- Two pop-up cleats on the swim platform

Bow

- Chain storage
- Two storages on the sides of the anchor winch. Fiberglass door to cover the anchor winch area and the two side storages. Two watertight lights to light the area. Fresh water hose.
- Two electric wipers for forward windows
- Sunbathing cushions with bimini top, cushions, central headrest, glass holders and stainless steel handrails
- Black mesh covers for frontal and sides wheelhouse windows
- Hatch from the VIP cabin

Cockpit and Transom

Teak on the swim platform Two structural staircases in fiberglass with steps in teak to access the swimplatform. Stainless steel handrail on the external side of each staircase Electro-hydraulic retractable gangway in stainless steel and teak on transom, portside Water shore connection, shower, fresh water outlet in a storage placed on transom on starboard side Shore power inlets, TV and phone inlets and FM200 system controls in a storage placed in the centre of the transom Storage with door placed on portside, next to the staircase to cockpit Door to access lower deck/crew quarters placed in the middle of transom

- Salon door in tempered glass and stainless steel divided into two sections, one sliding and one fixed
- Two stainless steel gates to close the staircase to the swim platform
- Halogen lights placed on the aft cockpit ceiling
- Covers for cockpit table and settee
- Drainage holes

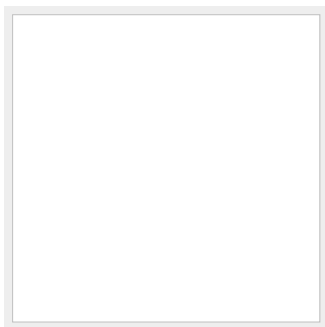
