It was designed for their comfort when on board where they entertained people for dinner gatherings and long range cruising. The owner's wife, unlike many boating wives, loves to cook. This design was copied in many respects by Westbay in later models.

The enclosed bridge was wanted for comfort in long range cruising and to be used as an office for the owner. Open bridges in Florida are not very pleasant when the temperature is 90 degrees and the humidity is through the roof. Running boats from down below with restricted visibility in traffic or dangerous areas is also very stressful. Most of the boats in Ft. Lauderdale have air conditioned enclosures. The hard enclosure adds over \$100,000 to the cost of the boat if you built it today and this one was done by the factory.

The owner has a BSME degree from one of the top engineering schools in the country and prefers to do as much work on the boat as he can to make sure it is done right. He also happens to have about 6 patents in his work for Chrysler Corporation in engine development and his own Michigan companies. His wife of 50 years has a degree in biology from another top college. They also own an island home on the west coast of Florida. They lived on board for 3 weeks of every month at a very prestigious yacht club in South Florida and spent a month at a time in the Bahamas. The owner has owned and run boats for 60 years as boating is his passion.

The owner re-plumbed the entire holding tank system as he did not like the Canadian hoses used instead of the proper hoses recommended by the Sealand people. The system works perfectly as all duckbill and vacuum control valves have been replaced.

No one who has been on board has indicated the boat was anything but very clean. It's just in need of updating, just as any house would need after 17 years. Styles change. The price reflects the understanding of that updating. The owners have spent \$50,000 on some updates recently but mainly on the bottom of the boat to fix the blisters. This is a common problem on boats built in the 90's and early 2000's as knowledge was gleaned on the porosity of gelcoats. No expense was spared in this repair and it was supervised by a surveyor that the owner hired. All underwater gear including the "spurs" and bushings were inspected during this process. New zincs were installed. Epoxy was used on the hull and running gear.

Megabyte is still extremely stylish and there were about 100 of the 58's built. There were also 64 foot Sport Fisherman models built like Megabyte with the hard enclosed bridge and the notched down rear cockpit. You can't tell the age difference between years on these boats. Many still sell for well over \$1 million.

Megabyte has proven itself extremely sea worthy in that it came on its own bottom from BC and has proven very tough when crossing the Gulf Stream going to the Bahamas.
