Immediately upon boarding this fine little vessel one notices the size of the cockpit, where the vessel's 12' beam is most apparent. Under the aft cockpit bolster is a large fold-down bench. In the forward area of the cockpit on the portside is a L-shaped lounge with a tremendous amount of storage underneath. Directly across on the starboard side is a doublewide adjustable helm seat. The main cabin is entered through a plexiglass sliding door and down two steps. On the starboard side is a large U-shaped lounge which makes into a double berth. On the portside aft is the ship's head/shower. Forward of the head is the galley area, and in the forepeak of the vessel is the master berth, a large double bed with storage underneath in the form of drawers as well as hatches.

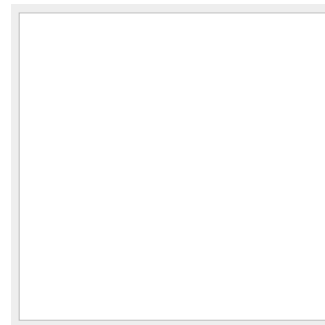
