Construction

- Overall Measured Length: 68'5" including 1' anchor.
- Hull: GRP, solid laminate. Painted Awlgrip Flag Blue in 2006.
- Deck: GRP balsa sandwich, with full teak decks, replaced 2004
- Superstructure: GRP, with Lewmar hatches and portlights and flush mounted hatches for Owner's cabin aft
- Keel: lead ballast, bolted. Fully serviced and inspected in 2010
- Interior: attractive cherry interior woodwork with high gloss finish, and teak and holly soleboards.
- Cream vinyl headlinings. The interior has been refreshed 2010 including refinishing of the varnish work in many areas.

- Perkins 6354T turbo-charged, 165hp, six cylinder diesel (Fully overhauled 2009 by Berthon)
- Jabsco electro-magnetic clutch bilge pump
- Propeller: 3 blade Brunton propeller overhauled 2010 and stainless steel shaft

- Wiring, cables and pipework rationalised by Berthon in 2009

The rig and winches are by Lewmar Commander hydraulic. This was completely rebuilt by Berthon in 2009, including replacement of the pipe work.

From forward – twin berth crew cabin with access to the retractable bowthruster and ample storage, with separate head compartment with Jabsco manual wc and shower with pump out. Aft there is a corridor with access to the U-line icemaker and washer/dryer and there are 2 double cabins port and starboard each with lots of cupboard space and en-suite heads compartments with Vaccu-flush electric wc's and showers.

The main saloon has seating to port with a coffee table and aft of this is a comfortable chart table of Admiralty chart size. To starboard is the main saloon table with seating for 10 people, with flat screen TV on the forward bulkhead. The saloon seating is in Alcantara.

To port aft of the Nav Station is the day head and a door to an upper and lower berth cabin aft of this. To starboard is the spacious galley with access to the engineroom. It is linear with massive refrigeration and generous work surfaces, and has a Force 10 cooker and microwave.

The aft cabin may be accessed from either the upper and lower berth cabin to port or the galley to starboard, and has a large heads compartment with separate shower stall; and a double berth to port and seating area to starboard. There is masses of storage throughout the yacht.

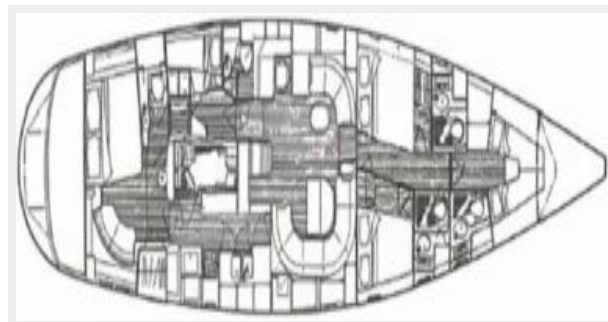
